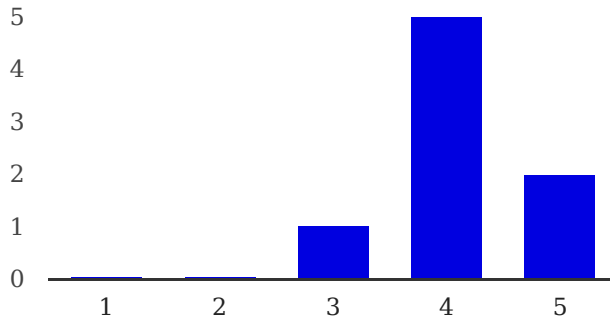

How did the course meet your learning objectives?



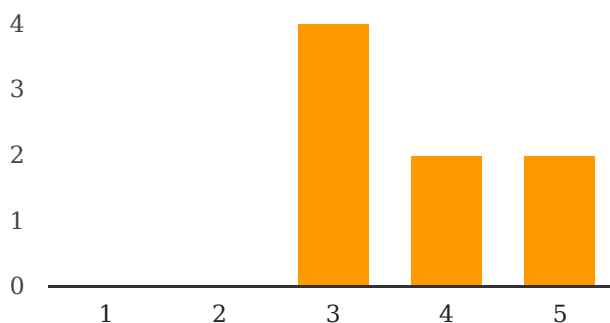

How was the duration of the course?

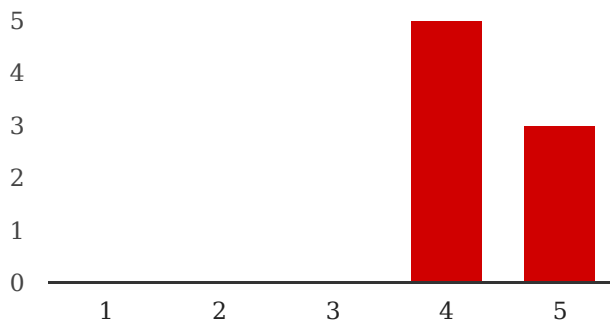

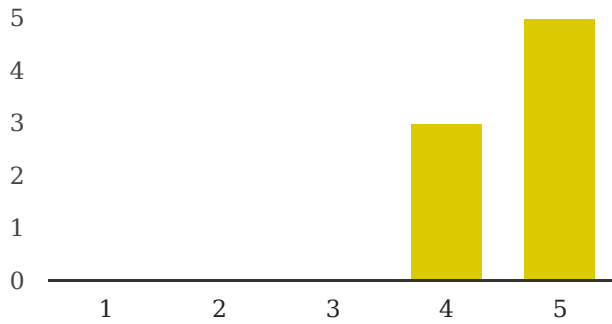

How knowledgeable was the instructor?



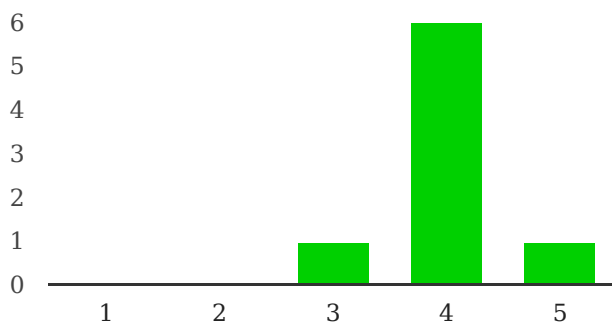

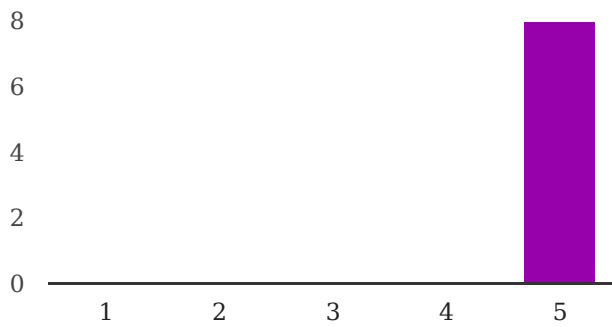

Was the instructor helpful with practical labs?

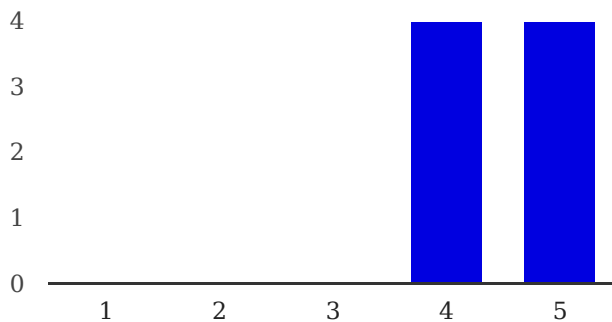

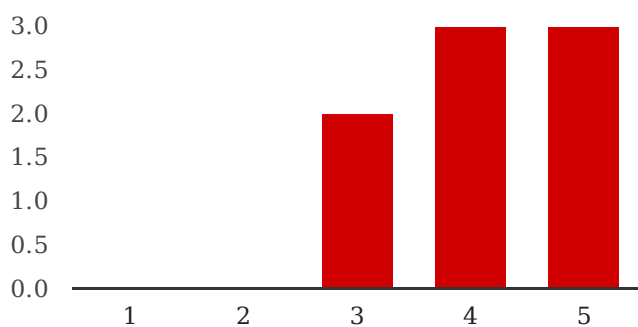

They were our own work computers, so this wouldn't really be the place to complain about them anyway, right?

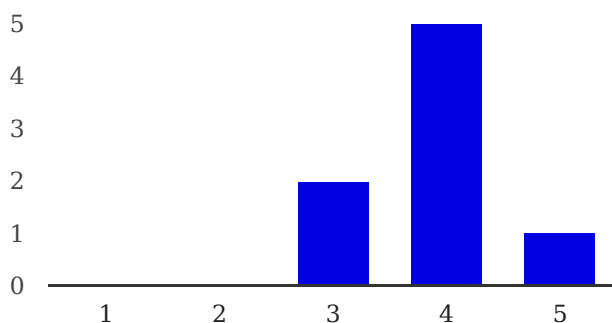

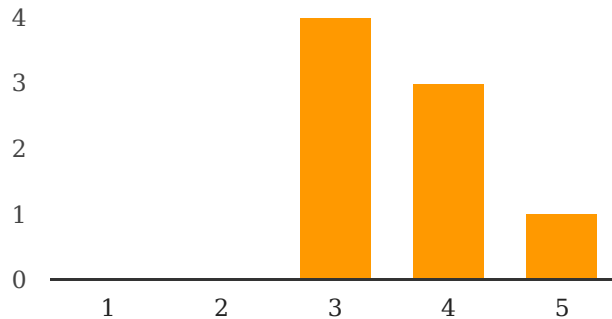

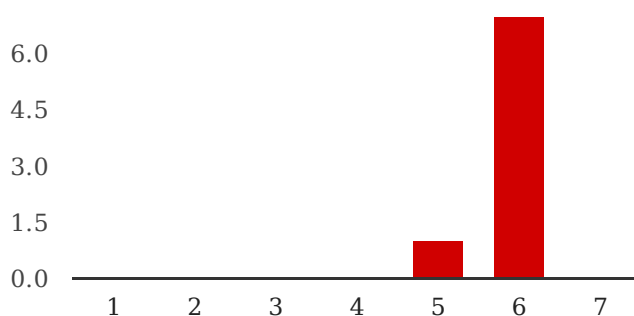

The pace of the course was veery slow. Especially at the beginning.

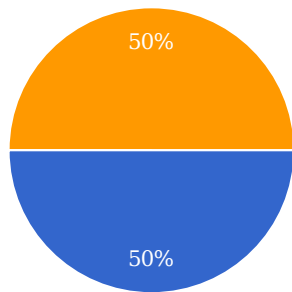

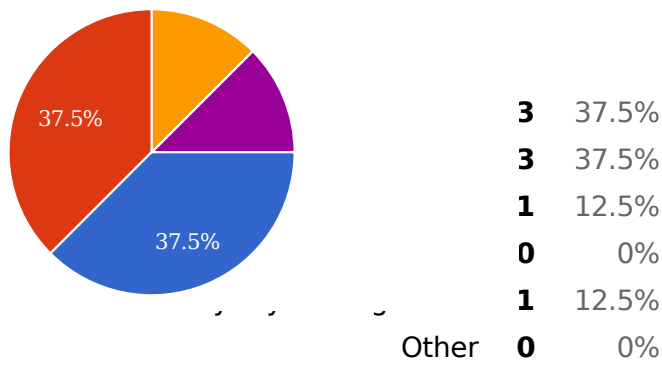

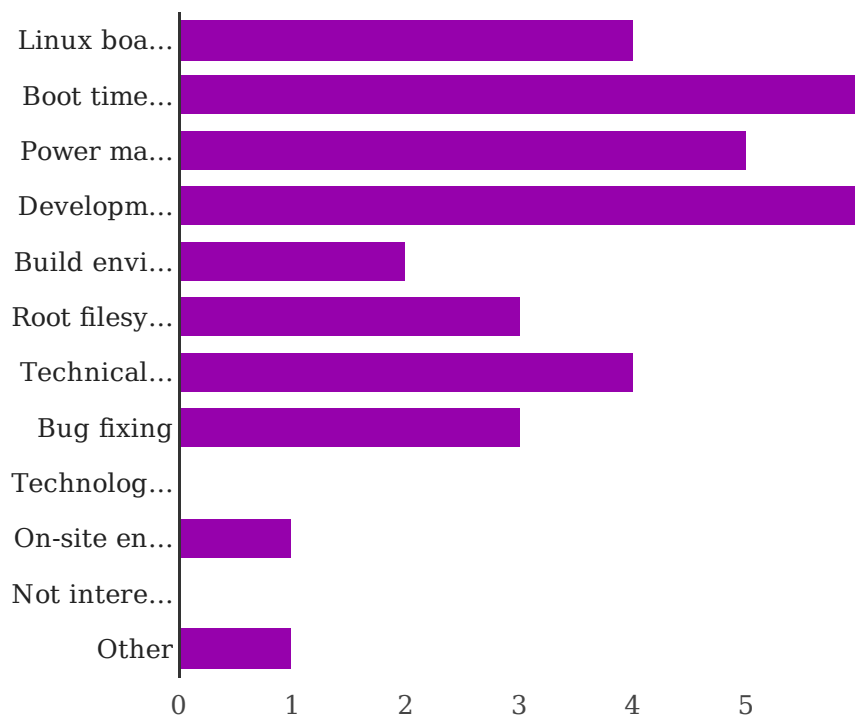
