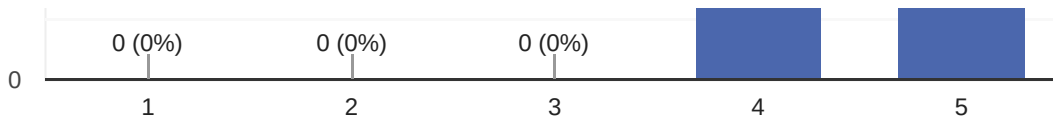
It was not needed but still its good to have this option to make direct comments to slides.

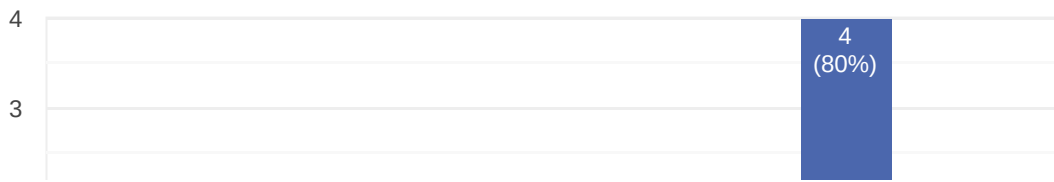
What part(s) of the course did you like least?
