

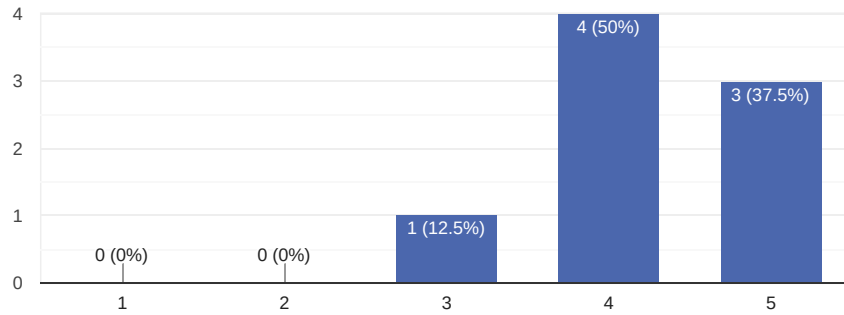

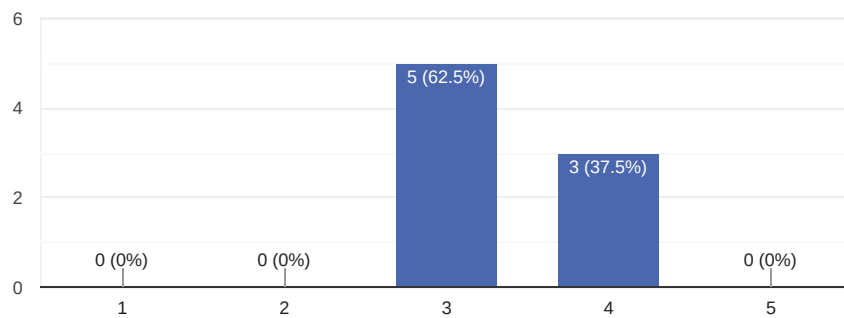

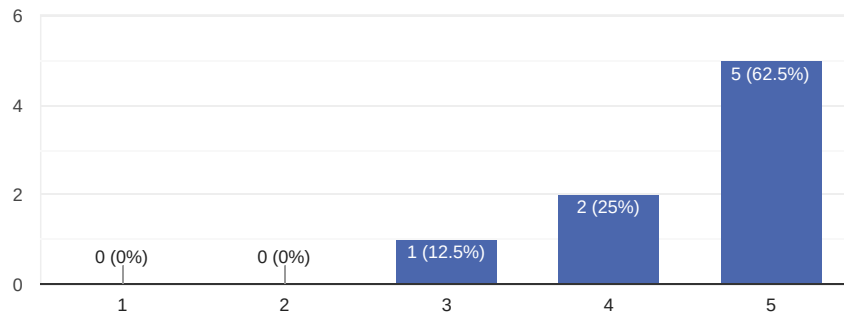
Just fine, the chapter about "Tools for the target device" was a bit too long, but still good as a reference

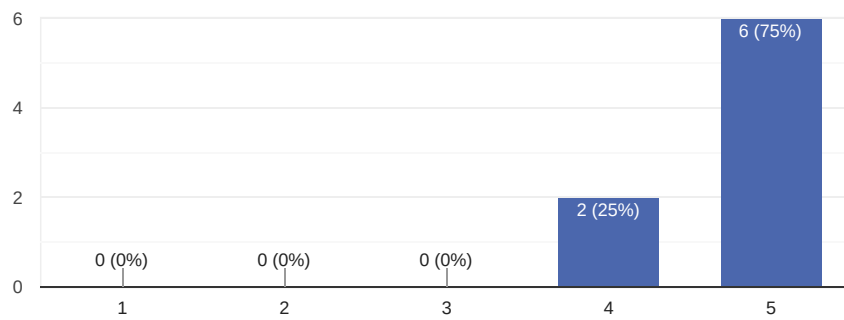

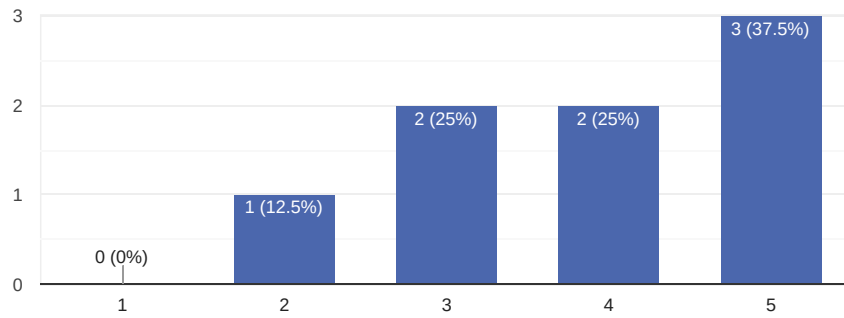

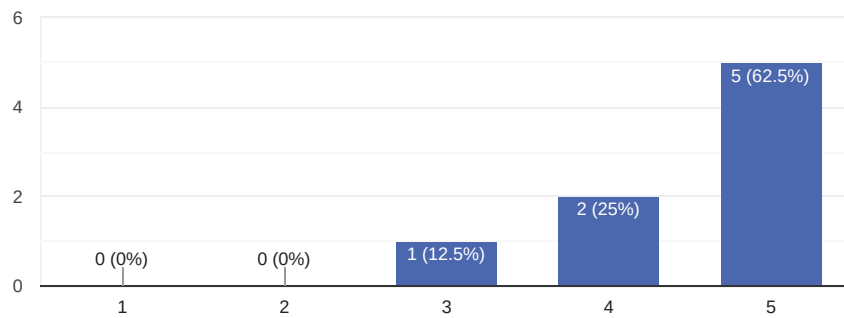
Slides are very accurate and clear, maybe better than some oral explanation
