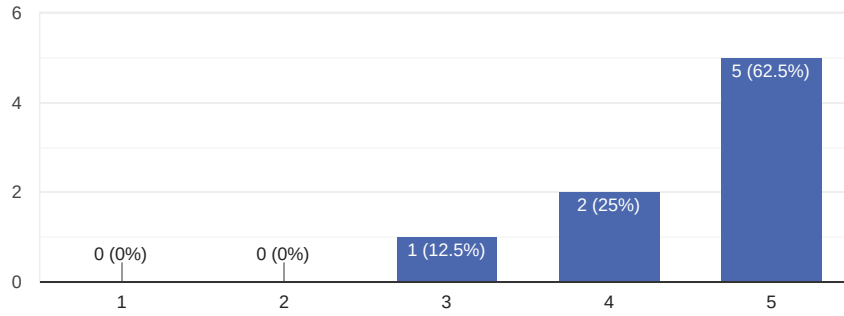

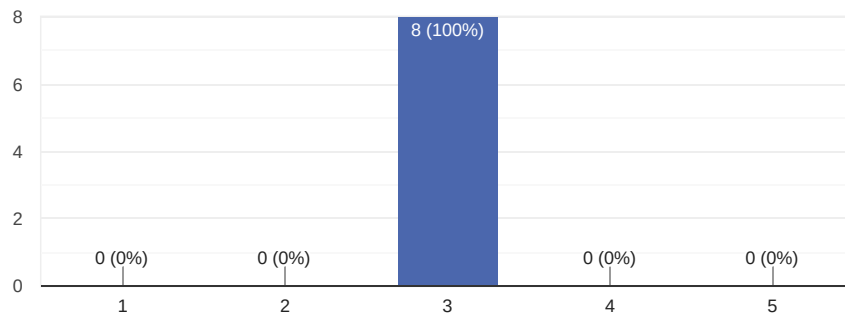
The personal real demo are better but in a remote training these demos are very well organized and needed to complete the understanding of the the explained arguments

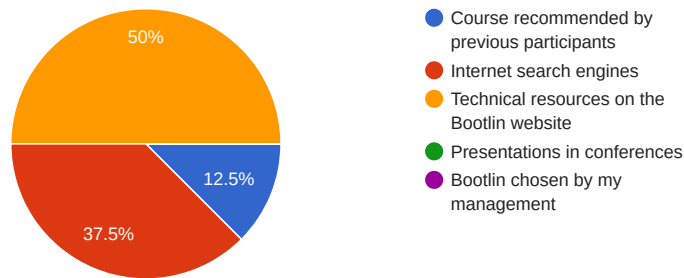
