

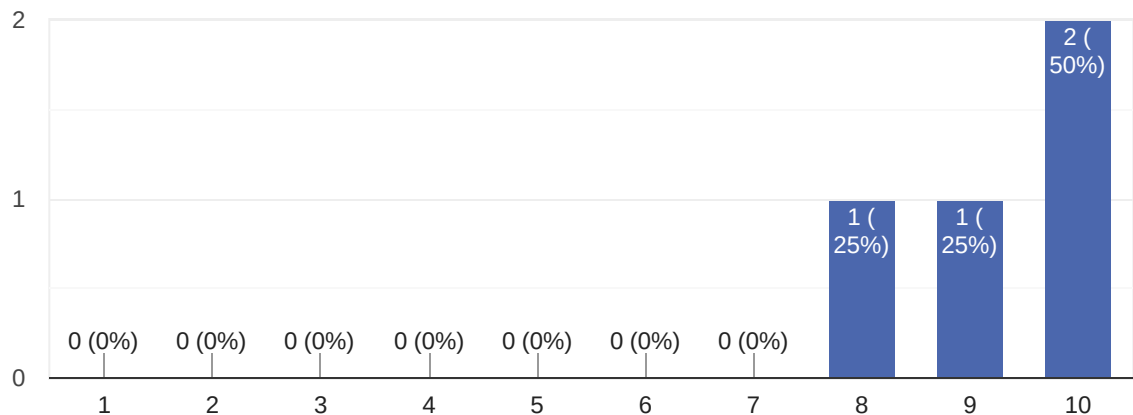

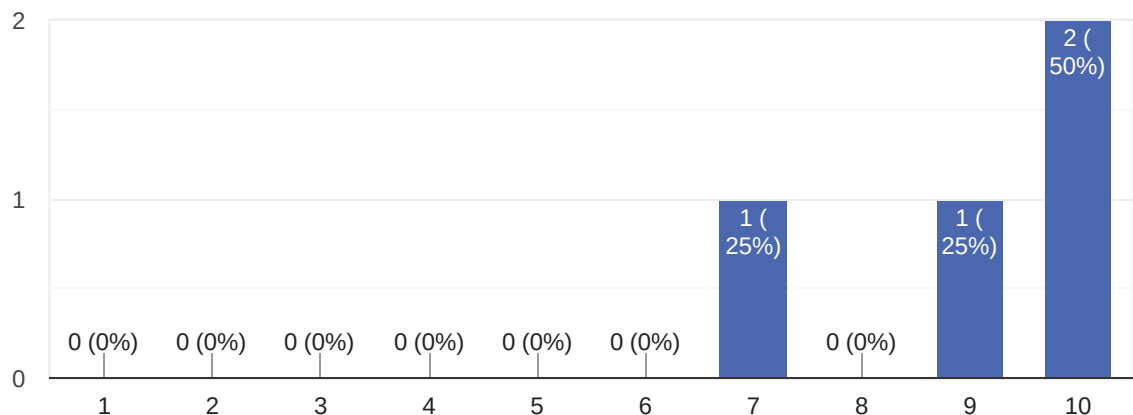
Fix the couple broken examples :)

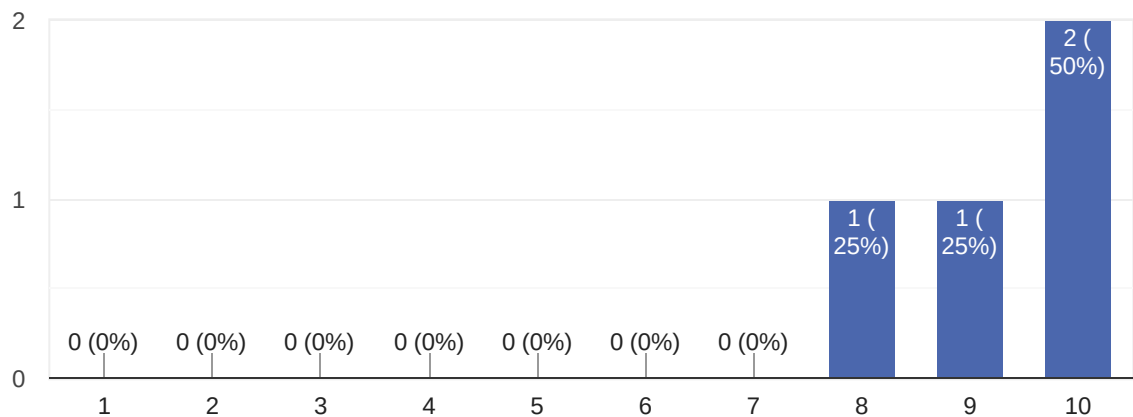
Alex is very knowledgeable about yocto, above and beyond what is in the slides and very patient and helpful with the "practitioners" as they ran into errors.

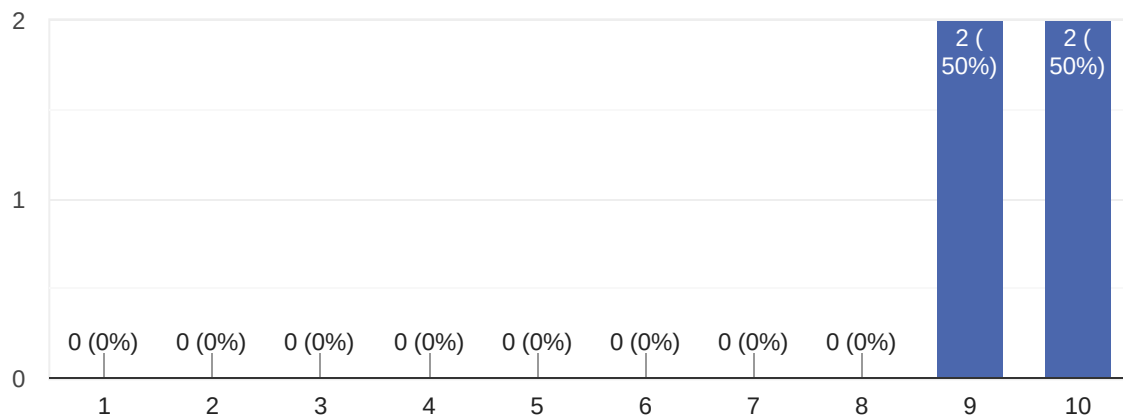
no problems

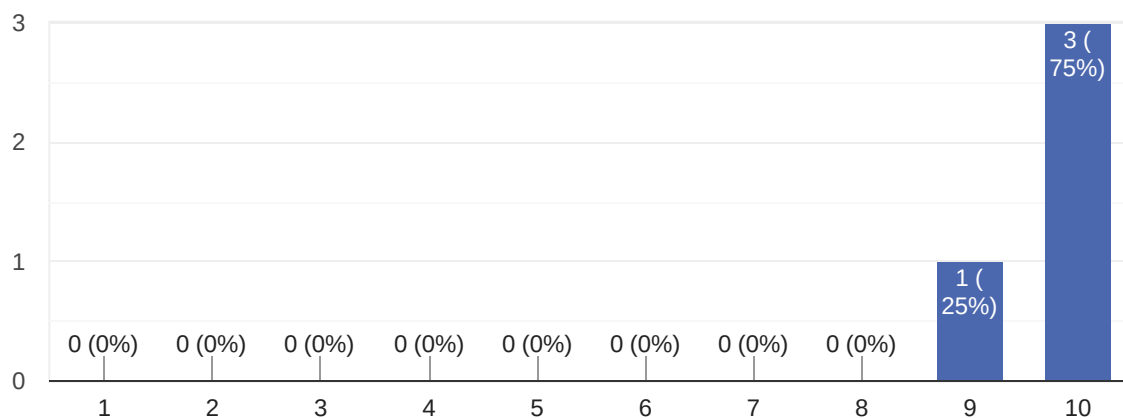

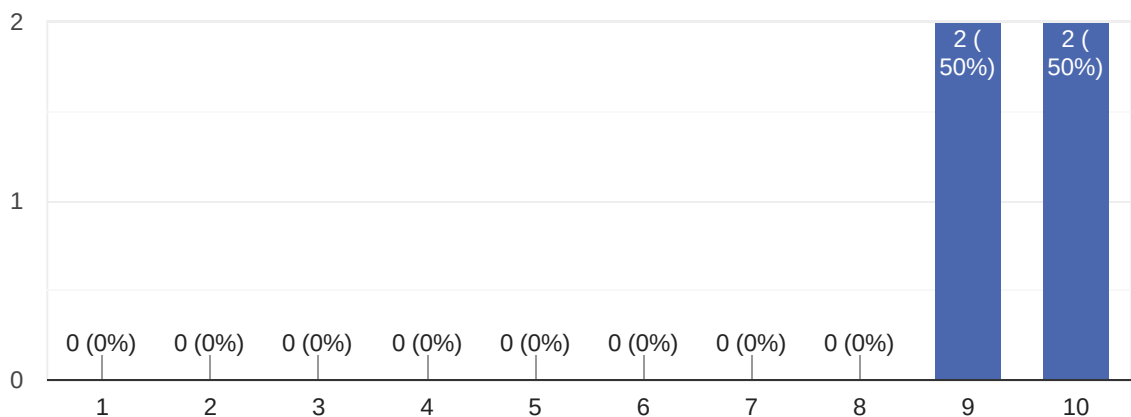

What part(s) of the course did you like least?

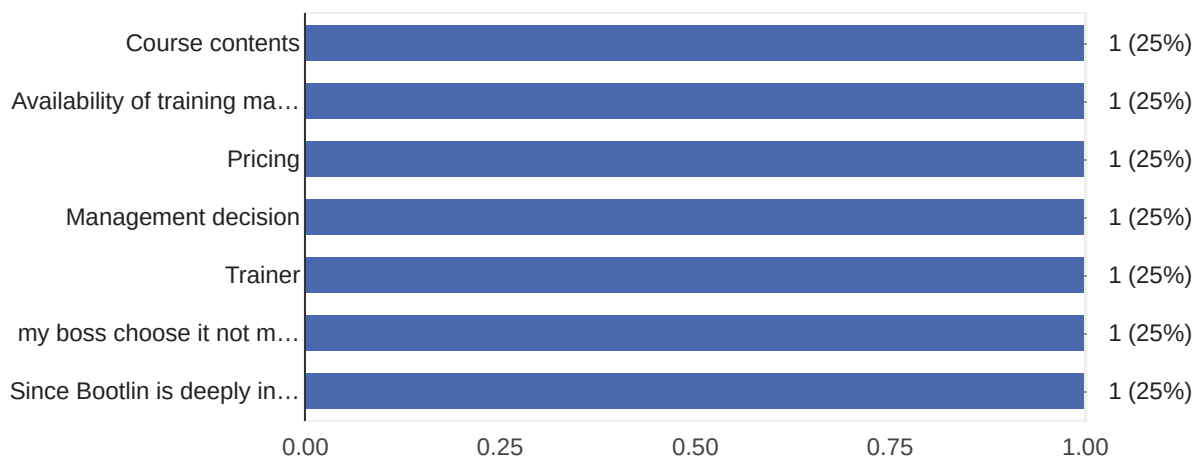
