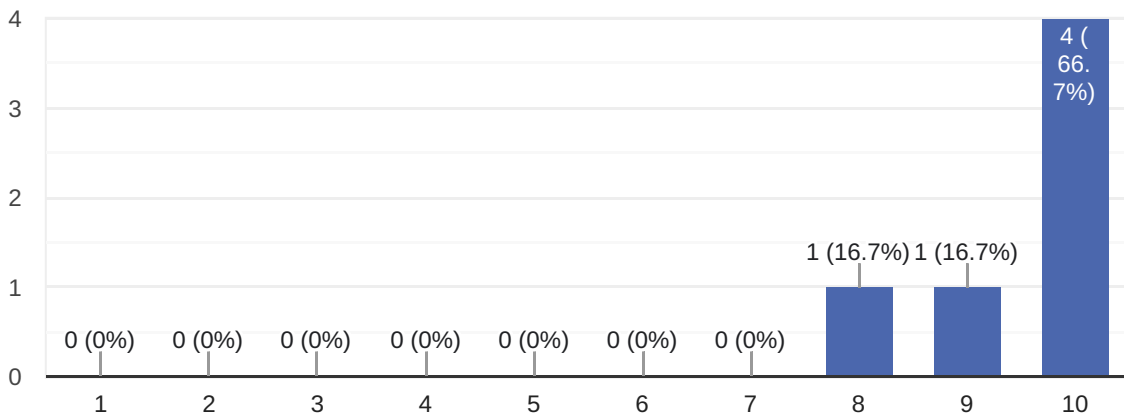

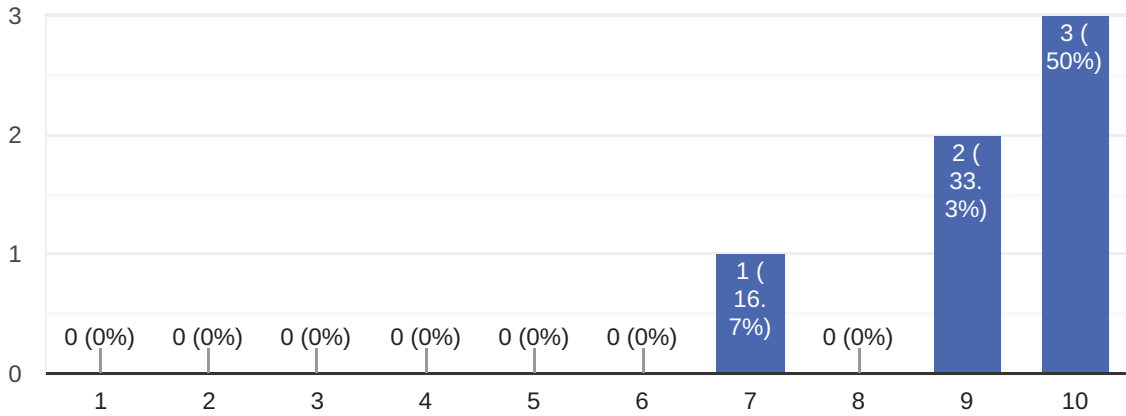

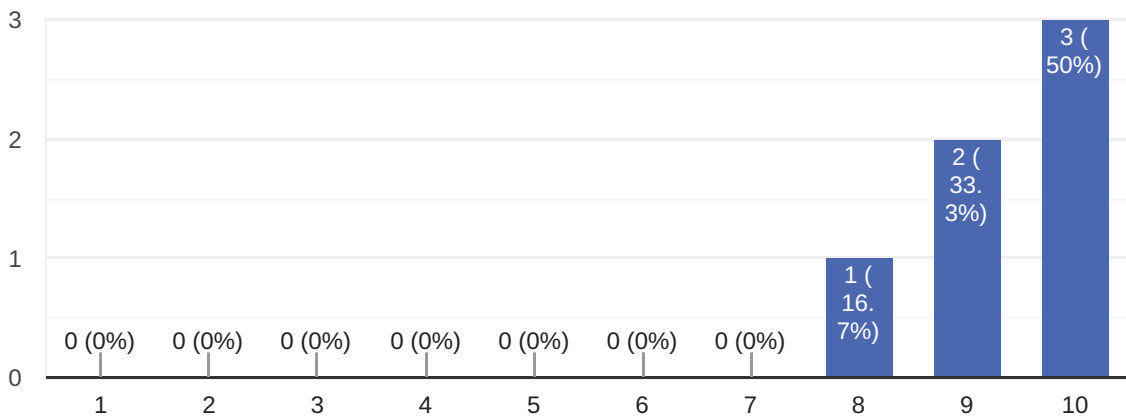

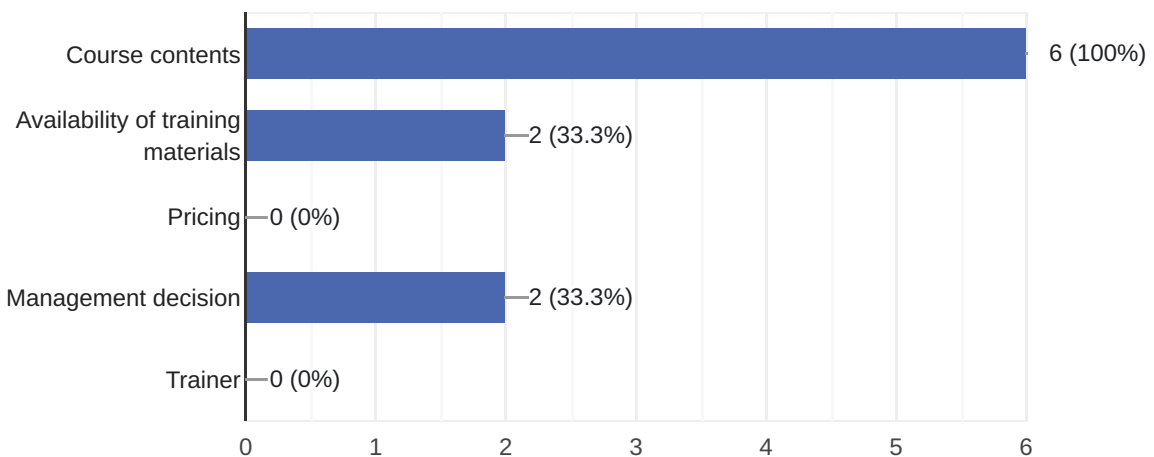
My network/PC issues ;) (but nothing you can do about it).
