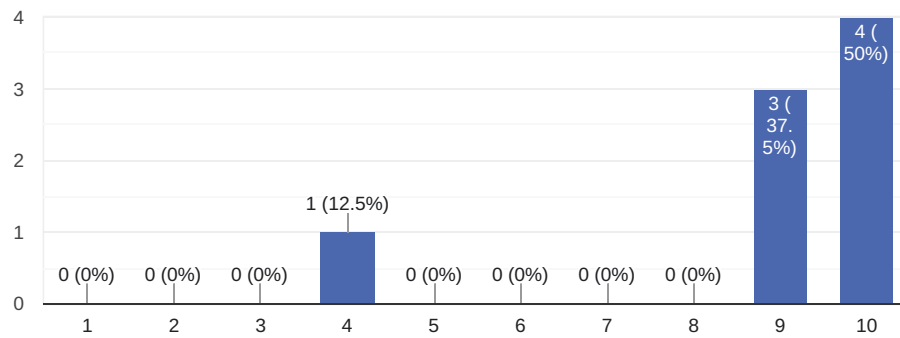
A little difficult to see on our projector from across the room but would have been better had we all been dialed in. I dont think it was anything with the training. A problem on our end.

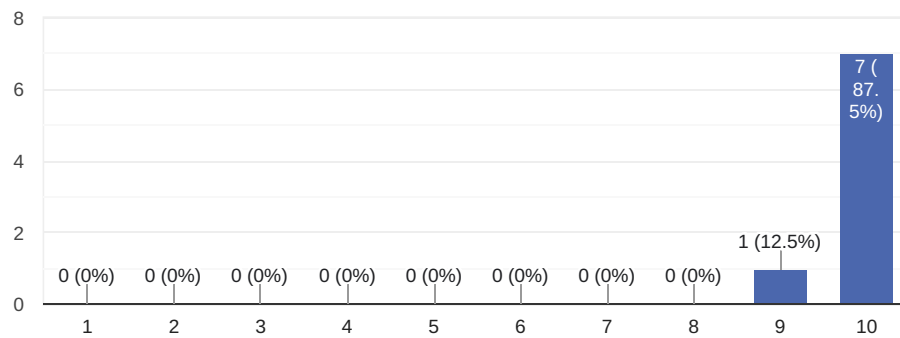

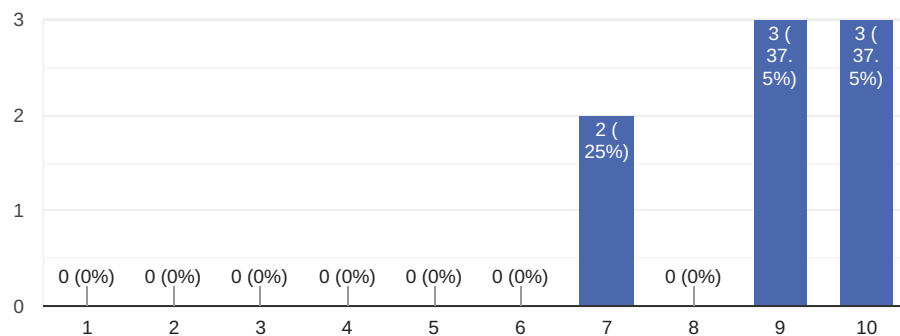

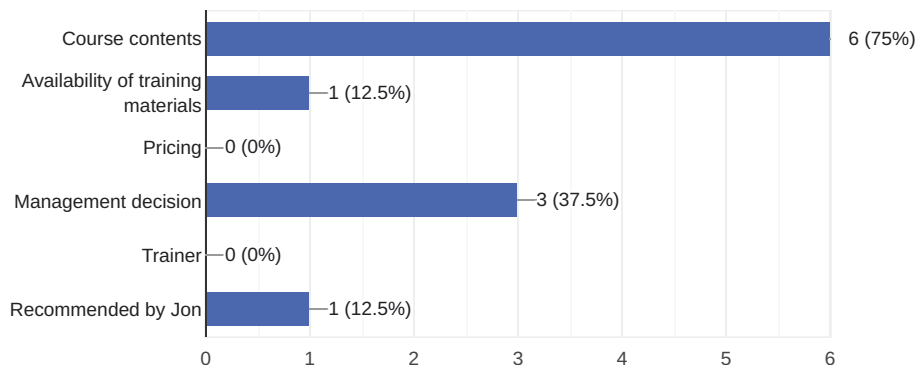
