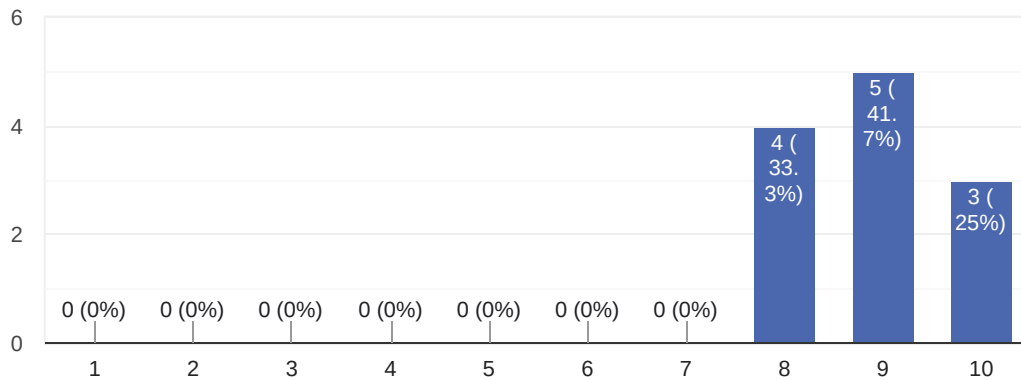

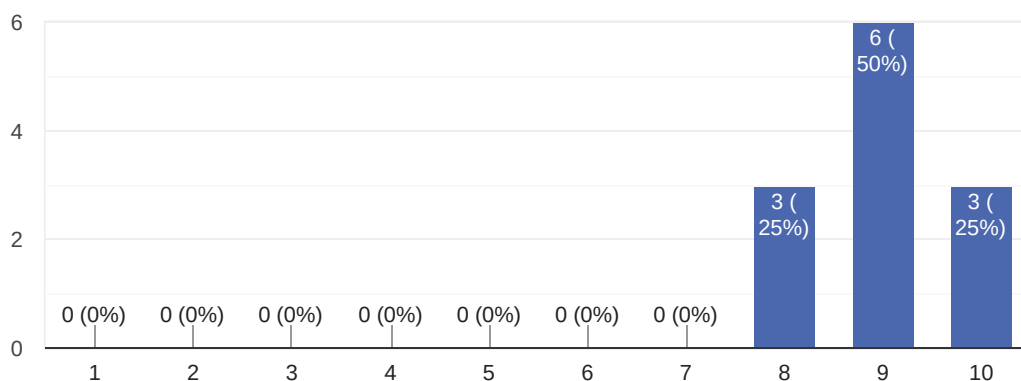
Provide a microphone for the professor to enhance the volume of the lecture. At times, the background noise and the distance from the professor made it a bit challenging to hear.

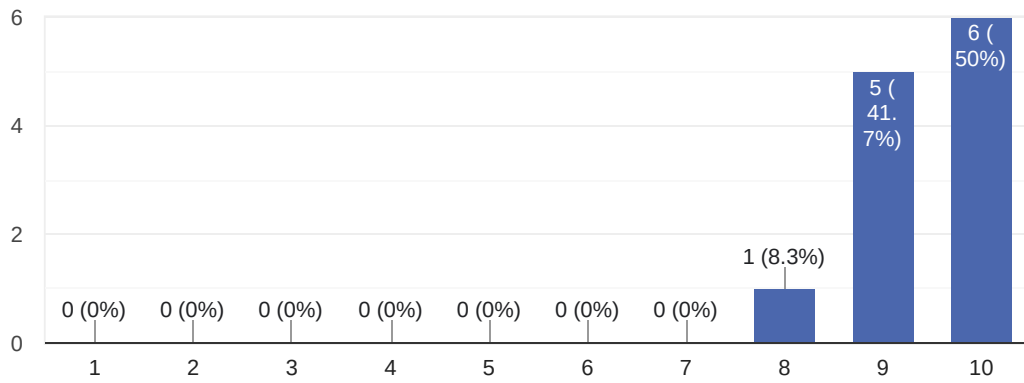

Some make commands were so long.

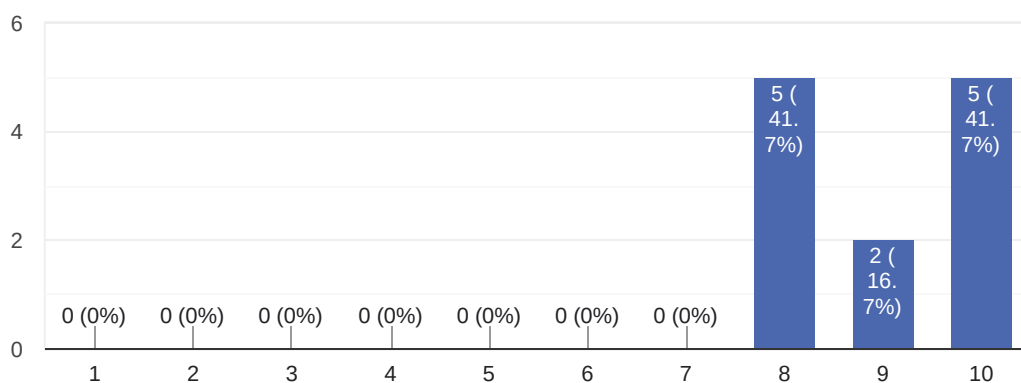
