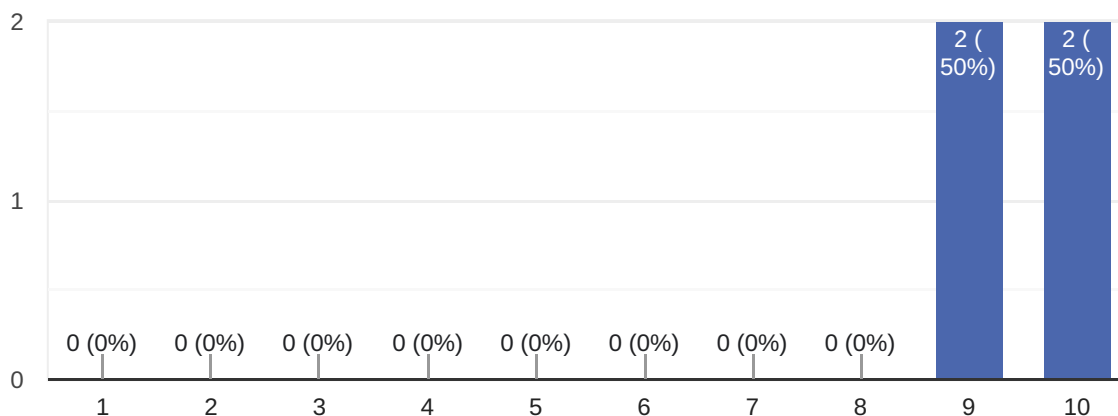

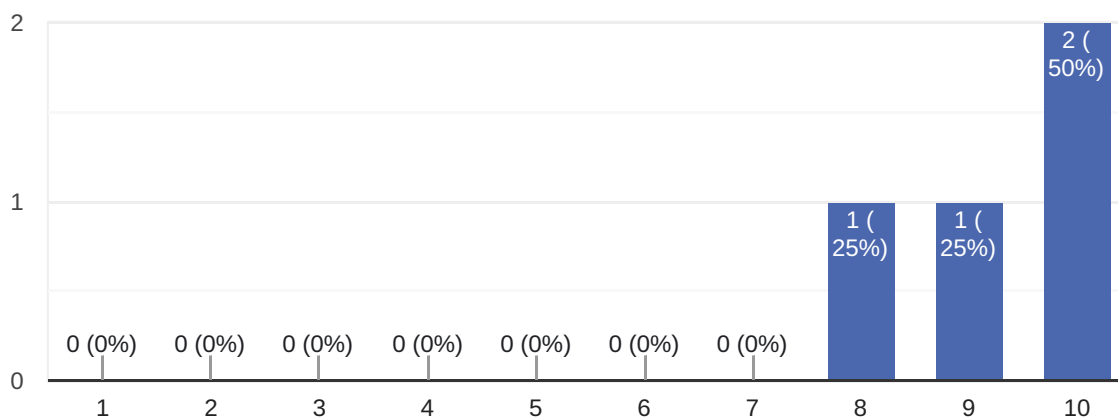
Very good course. But sometimes hard to follow when you're not already familiar with all the abbreviations. Very dense material.

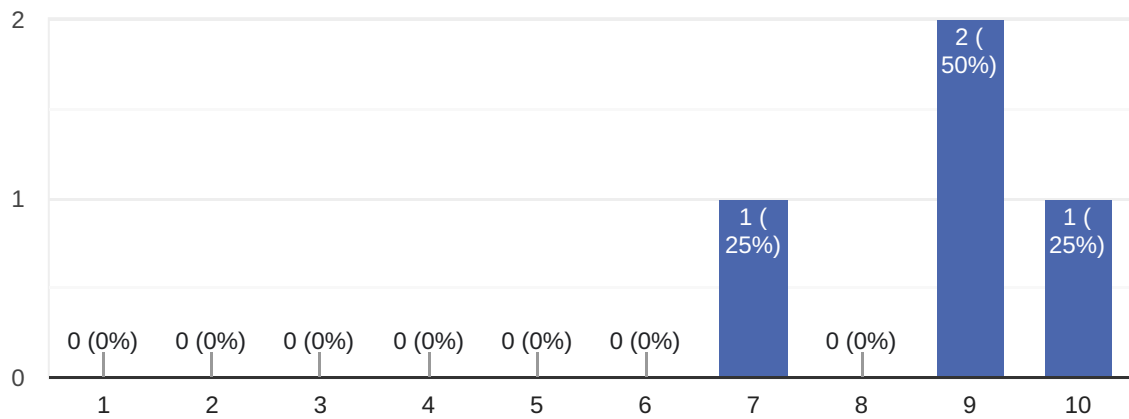

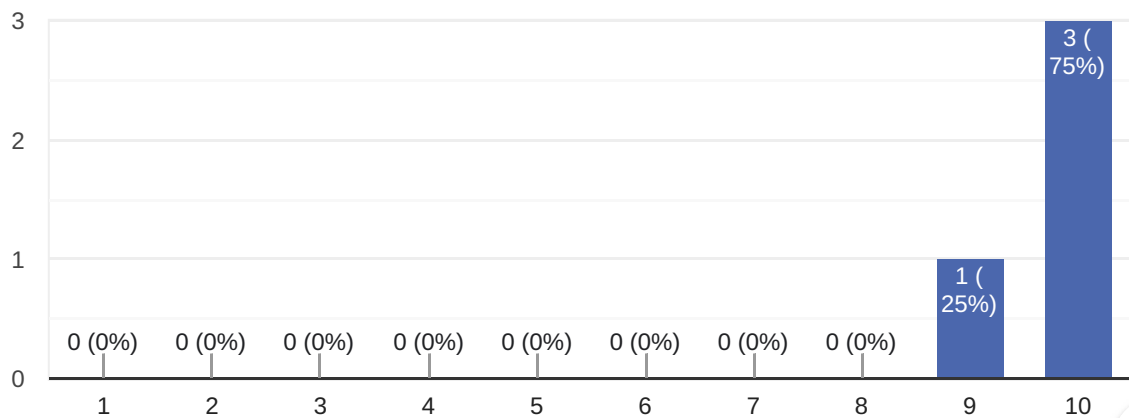
I liked them a lot, this really ties things together you saw in theory

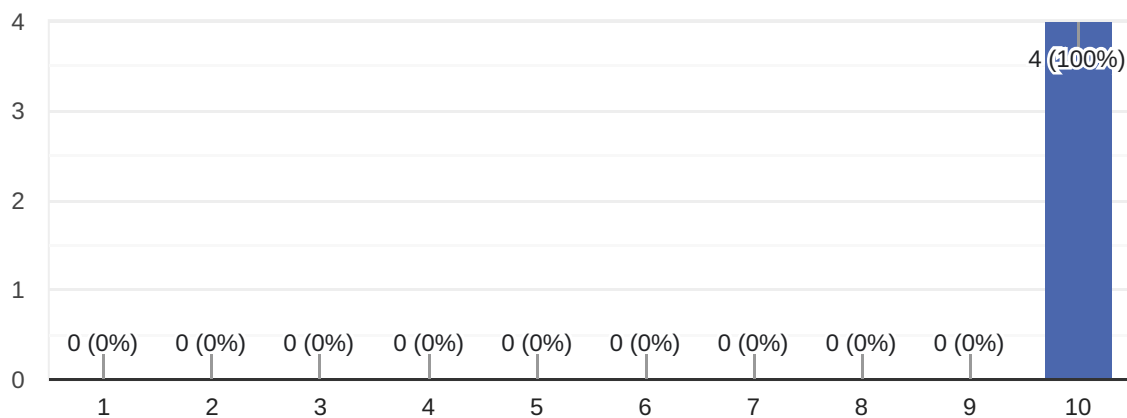

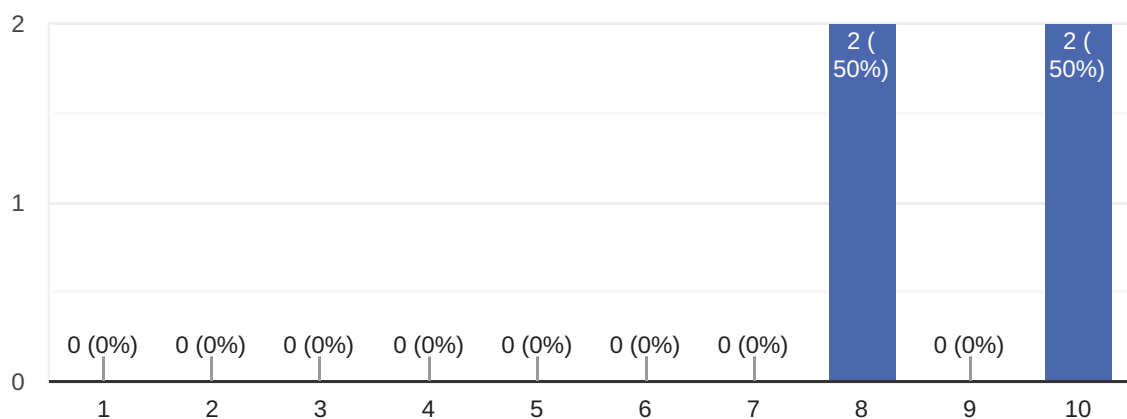

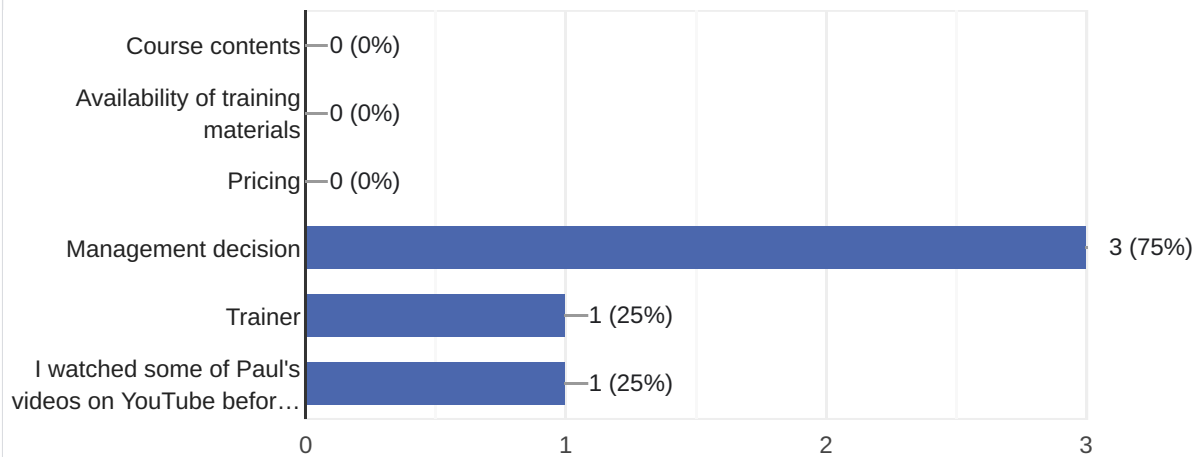
