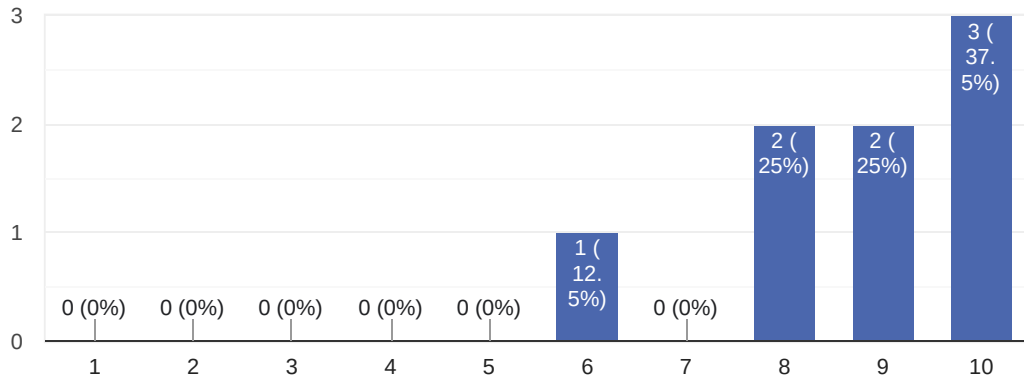

Great slides, great labs and especially great trainer!

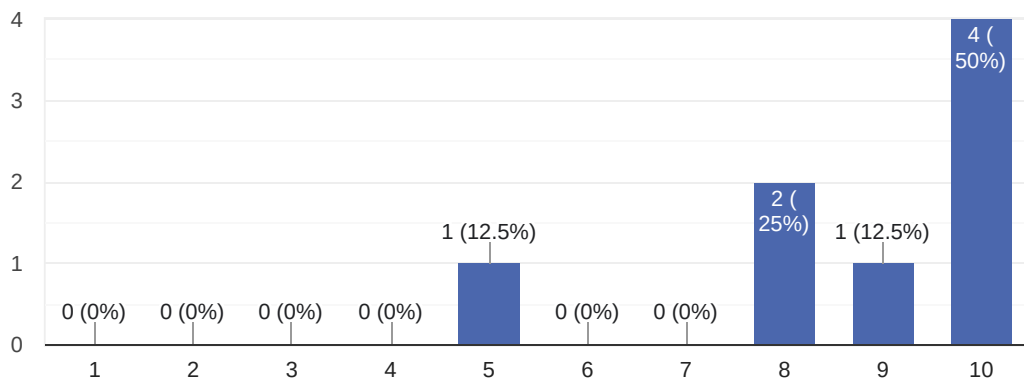
Great course! Slightly hard to pay attention to the lab, du to high tempo.

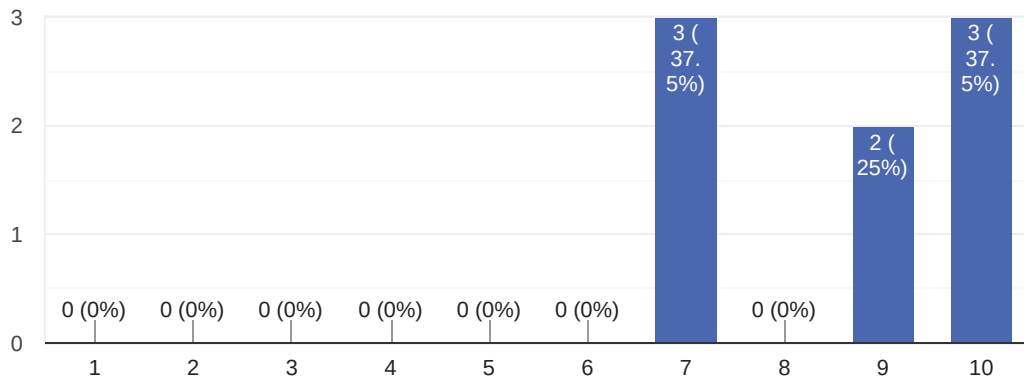

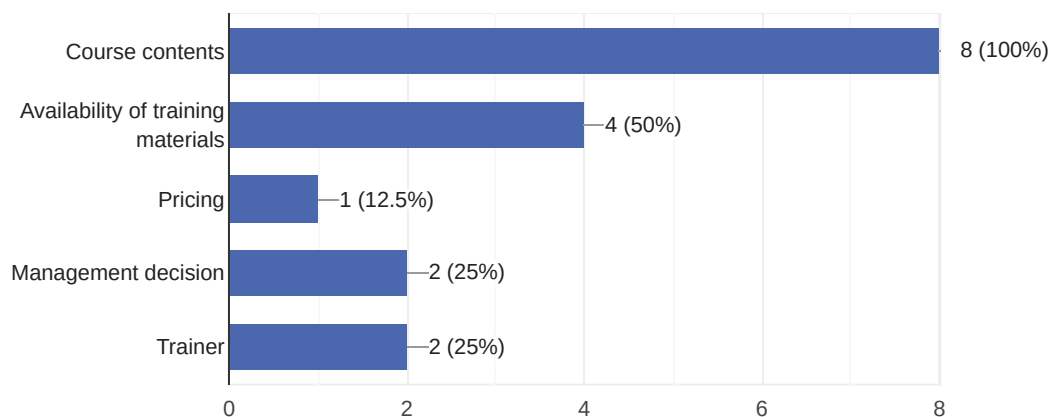
Following the lab was hard. In general a bit hard to pay proper attention the last hour. Quite a lot of information to take in and digest.
