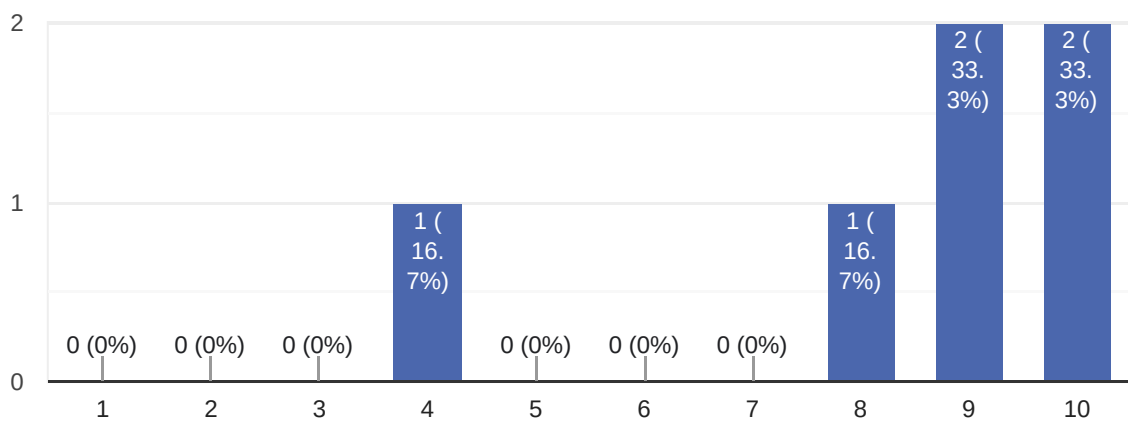
Marcos did a great job - he kept the group engaged and was willing to experiment with questions from the group, which led to a greater understanding of the material.

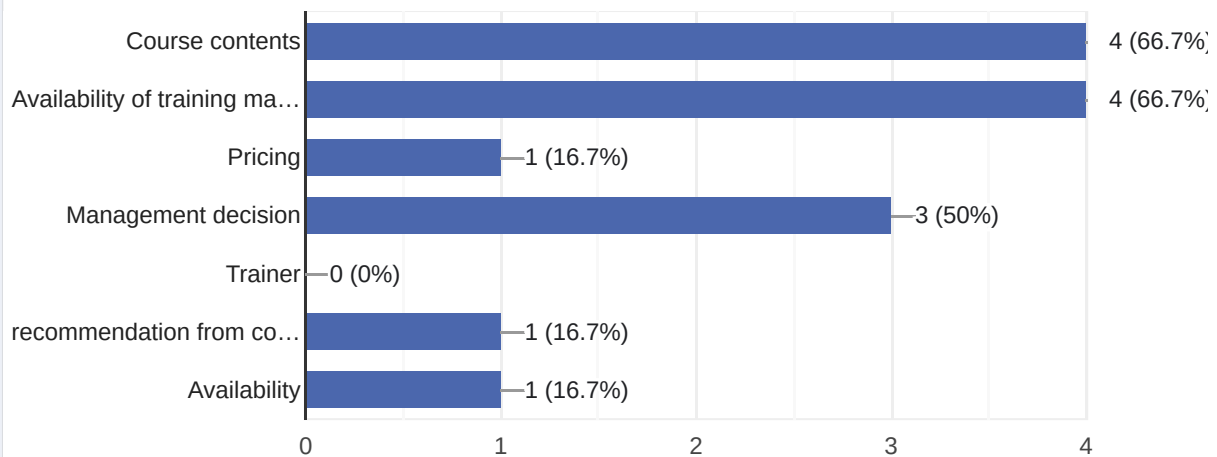
