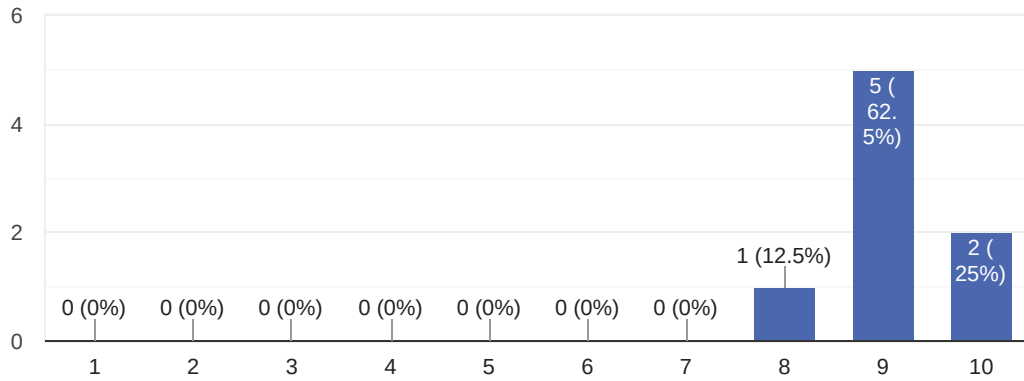

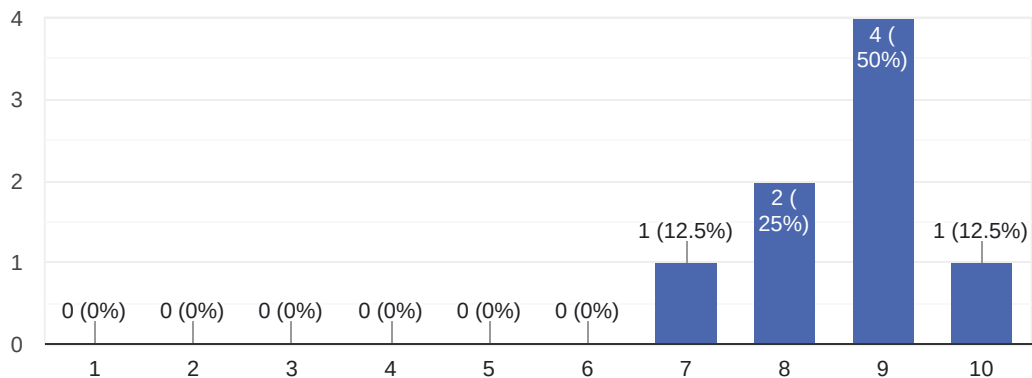
Not much to say, I found the balance between slide reading and practical exercises very good and the presenter very good at keeping things lively

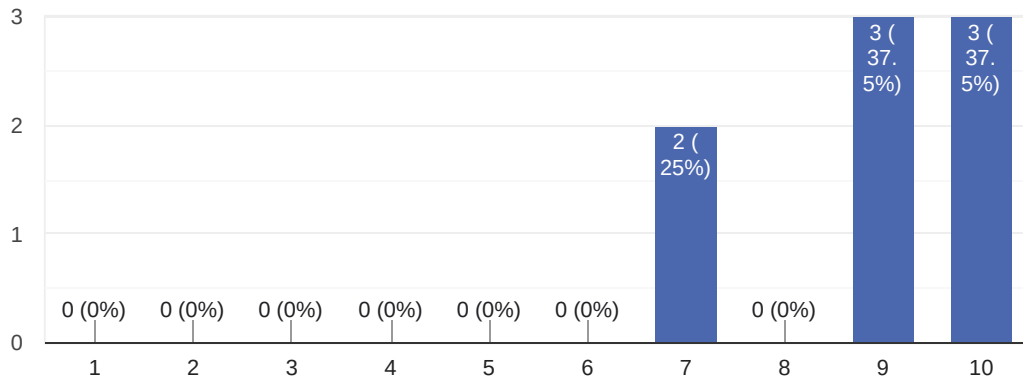
A lot of information, but very interesting and covered everything I wanted to know about

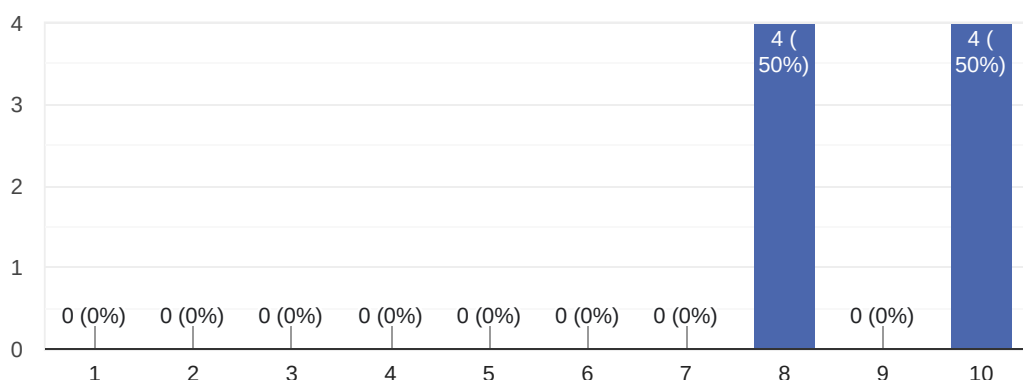
Great labs to apply what we learned

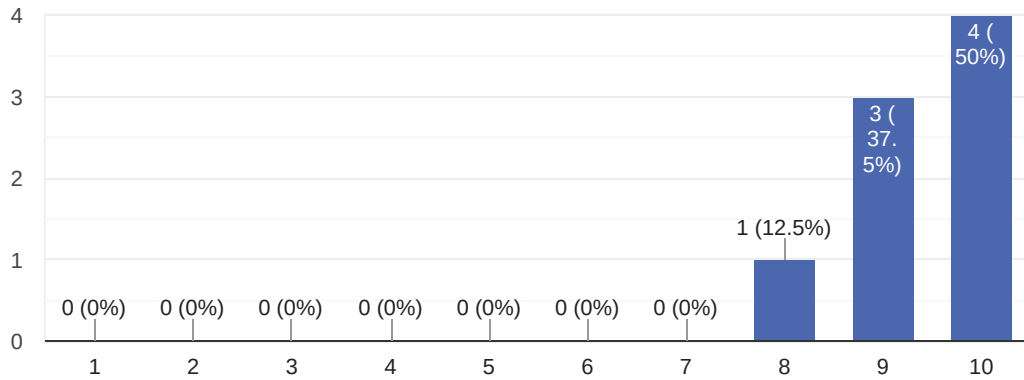

Very nice, good talker and effective to make his point understood

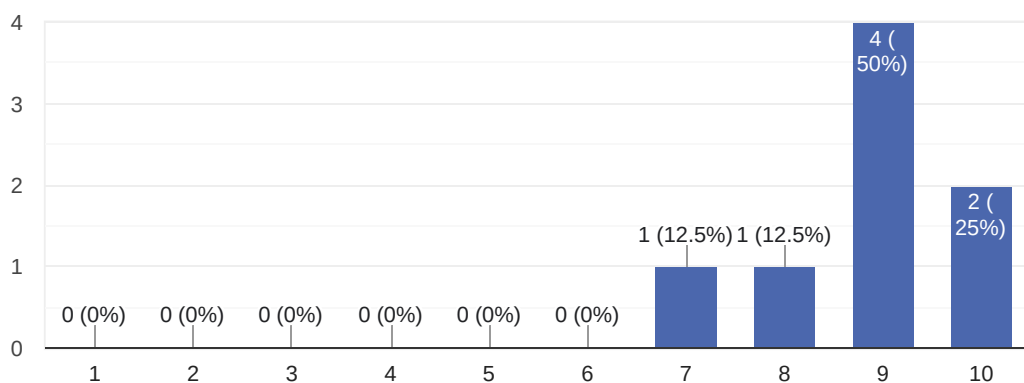

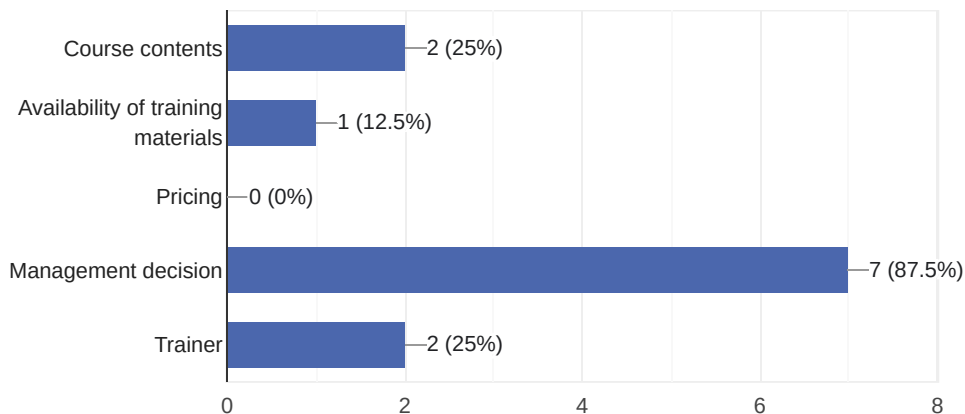
