What part(s) of the course did you like least?

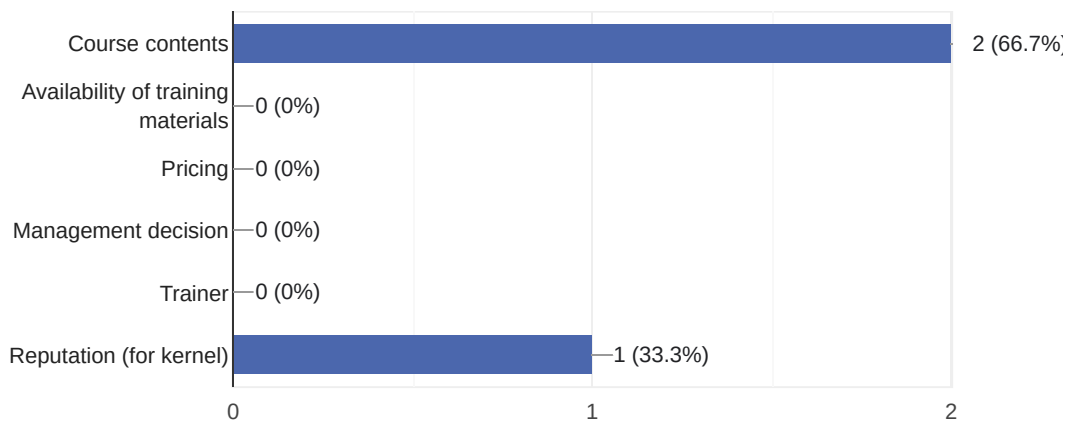
