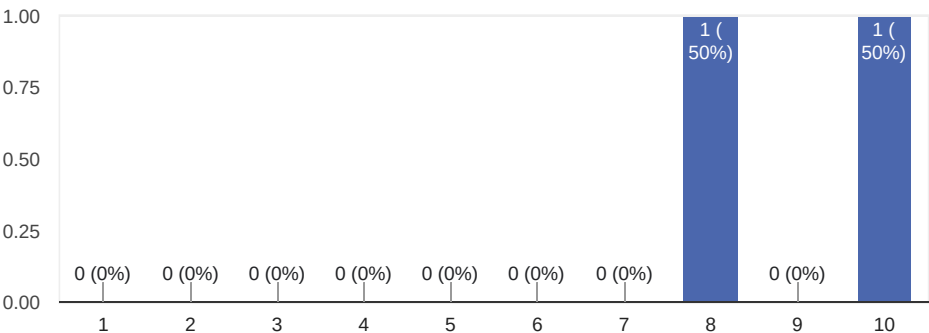

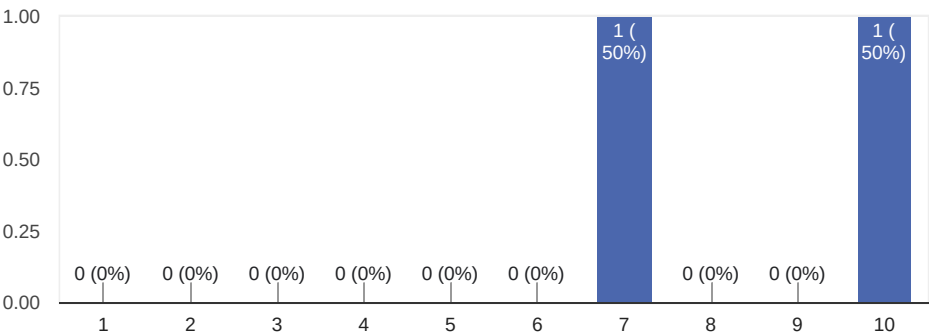

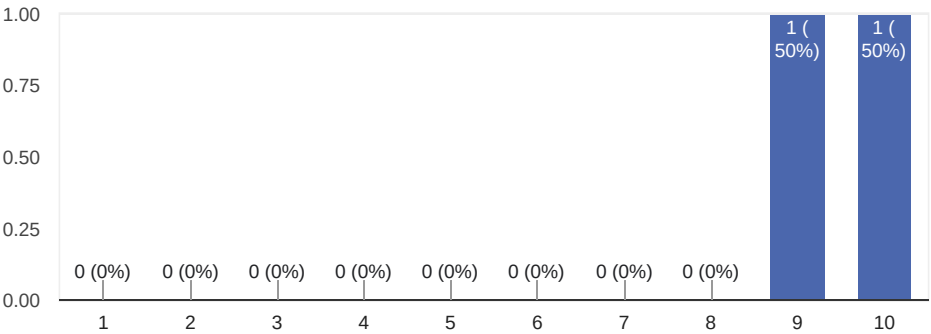
There is no doubt that the presenter is very knowledgeable on the subject matter, however in my opinion, it would be needed to create more engagement with the group.

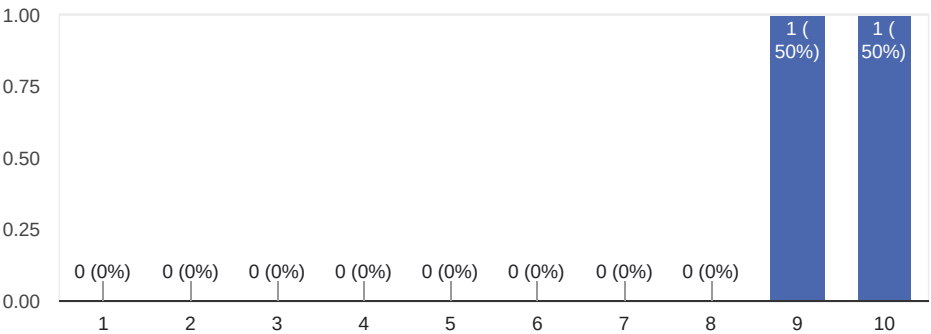

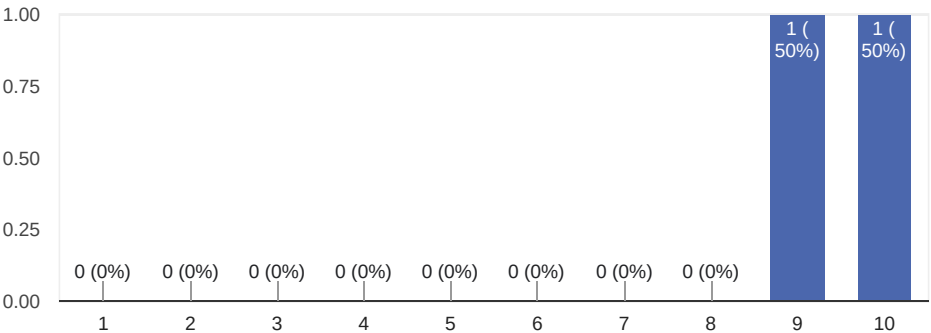

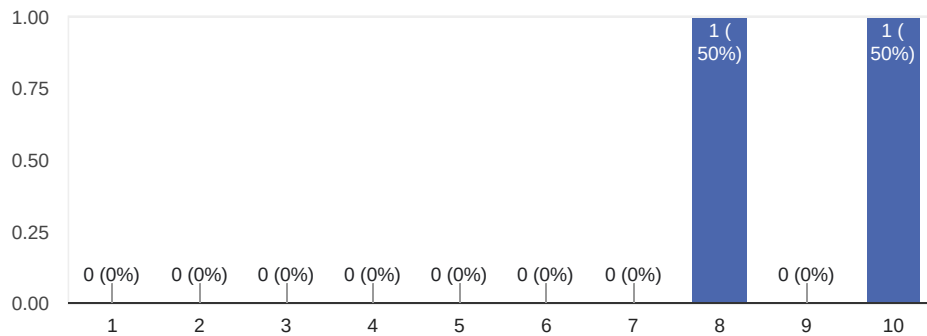
Kind and skillful. Impressive how he managed to demonstrate everything very smoothly and clear

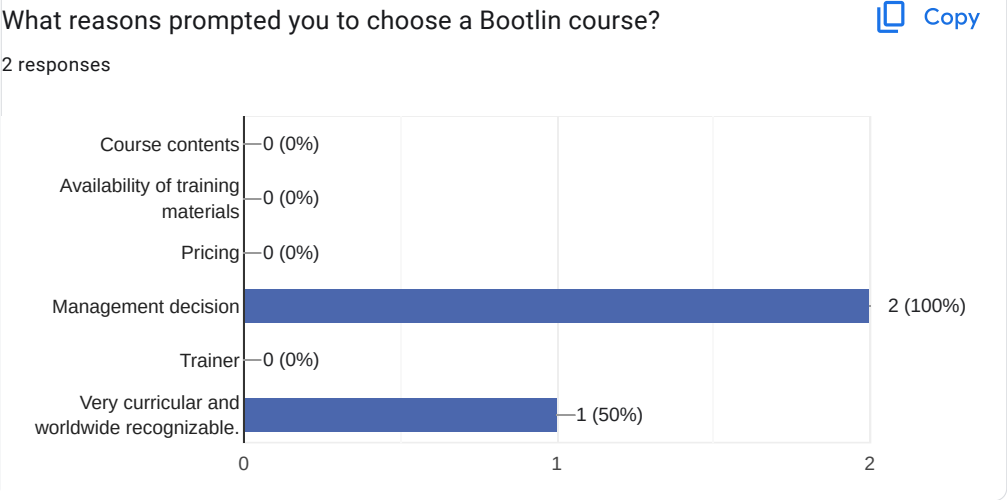
