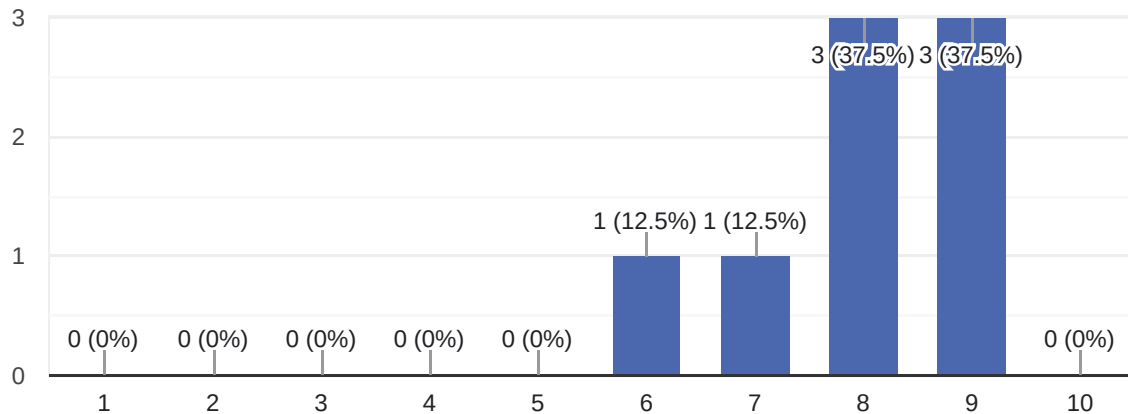

Very good!

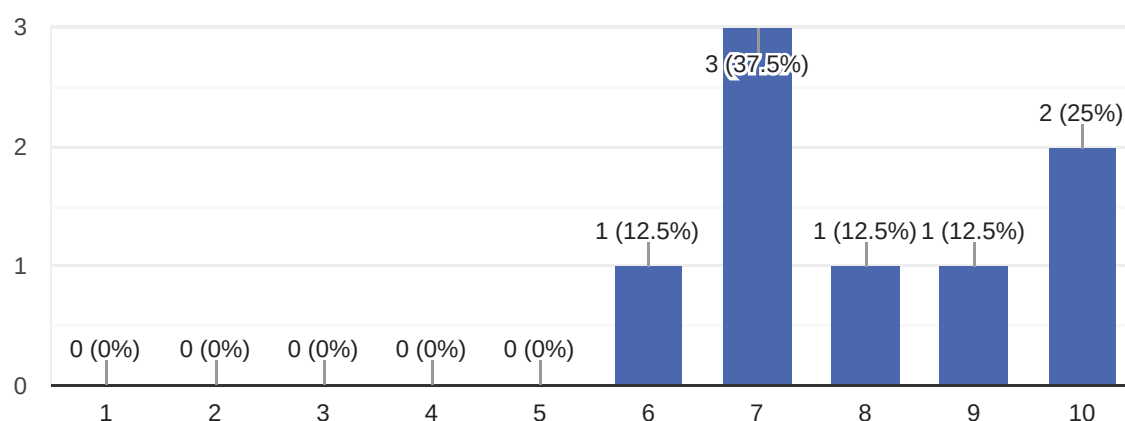
A bit more on LTTng/Trace Compass (like flight recording mode) would be great.

It would also be great to include a final summary that recaps all the tools covered during the training.

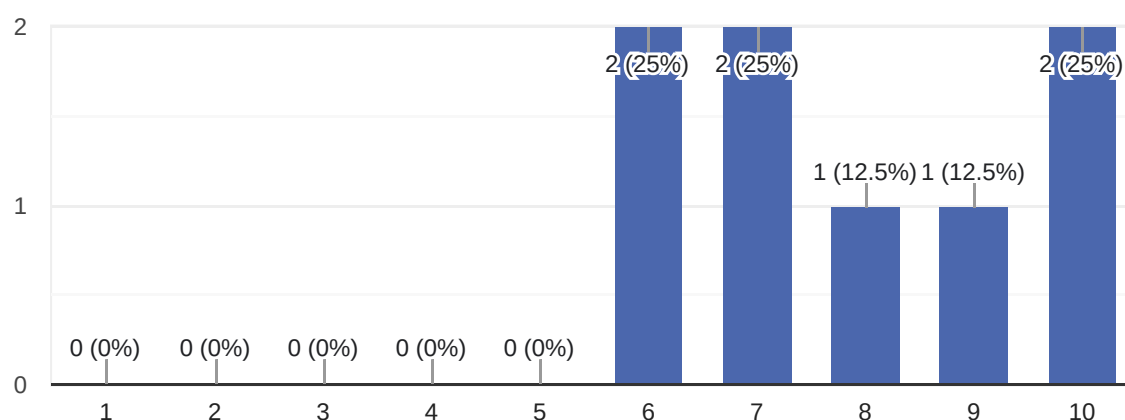
To much of it was to easy *to me* but I understand you have to be prepared to all levels of knowledge participants have so I don't have any suggestions on how to improve it.

The demos were very useful but unfortunately most of the examples were simple and I would love to see some real-world example, not something synthetically created.

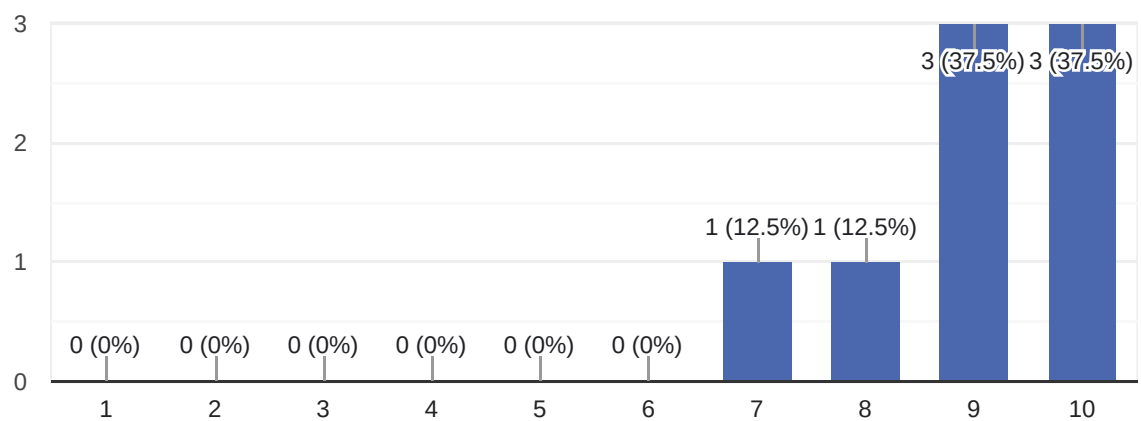

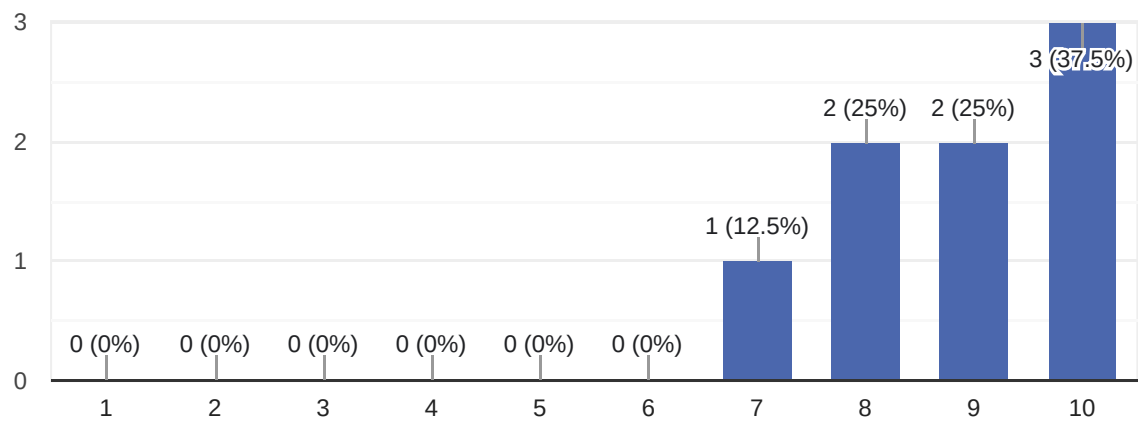
Everything was going very fast. This cours could have taken the whole five half days (and even more) and include more time for concrete examples

The trainer's preparation was impressive. To further improve the experience, it could be beneficial to increase interaction with trainees during the session.

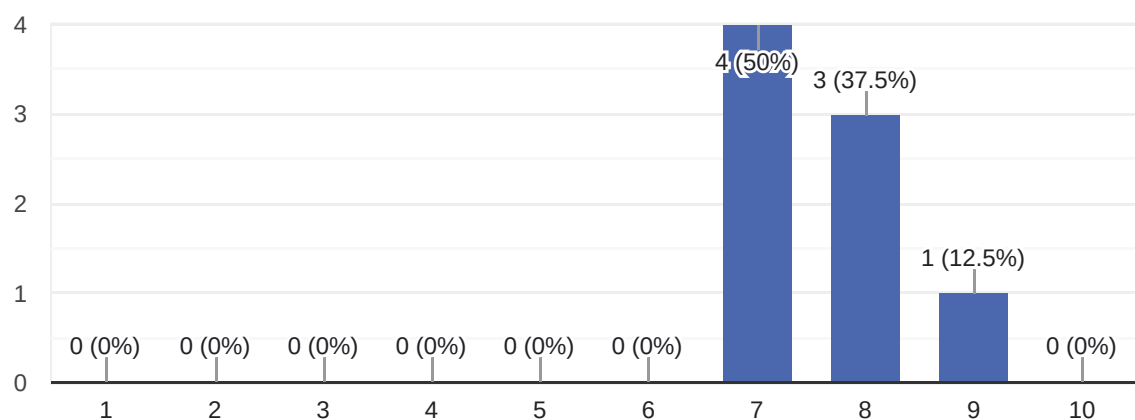

The latest part about the kernel debugging, since I'm not doing a lot of kernel work

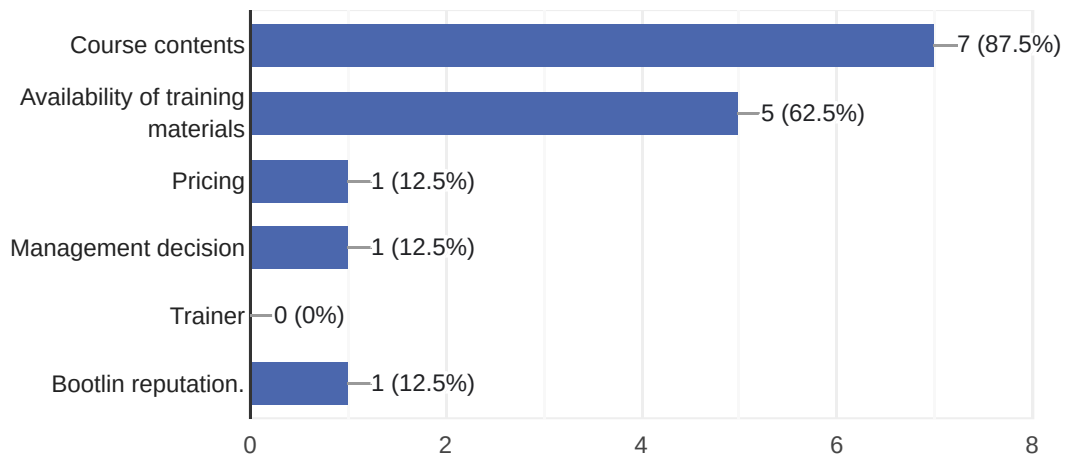
