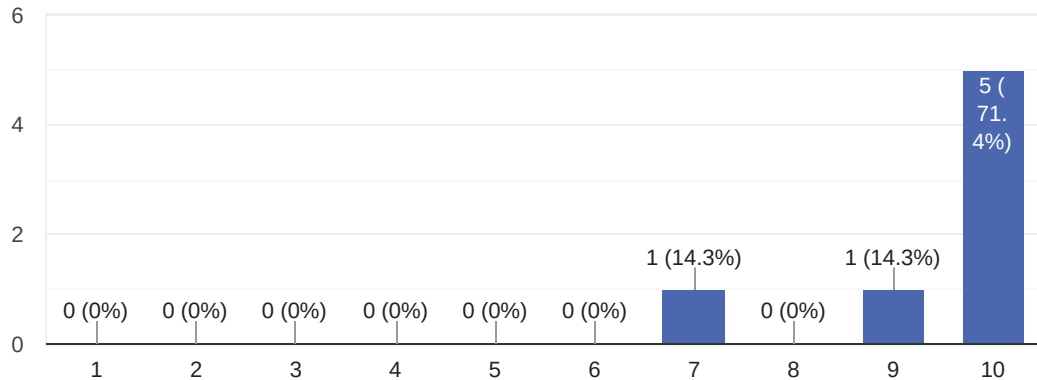

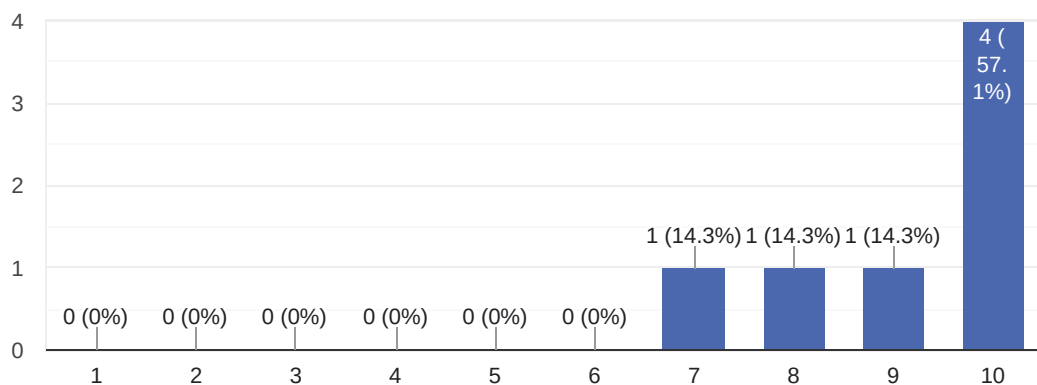

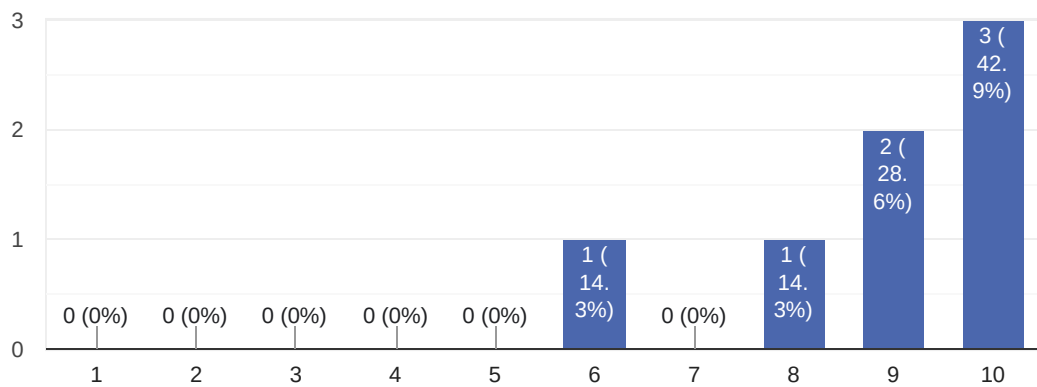
As with previous Bootlin course I've taken, I had a little hard time with topics that I was seeing for the first time.

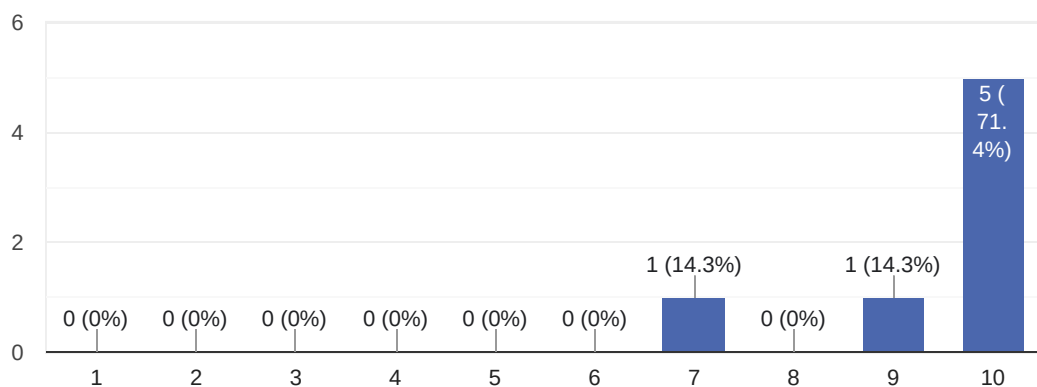
I usually have a hard time following live demos, that might be an issue on my end.

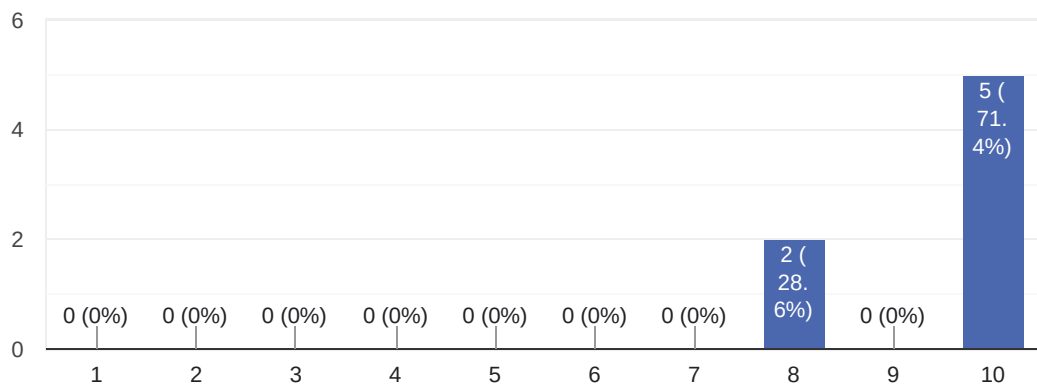
I really like the Bootlin materials in general. I wish there was more time in between lectures so that I could catch up on what I did not fully understand.

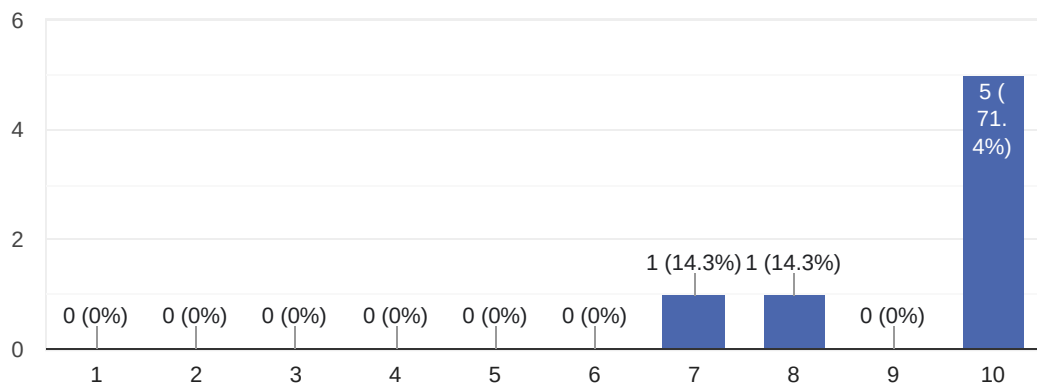

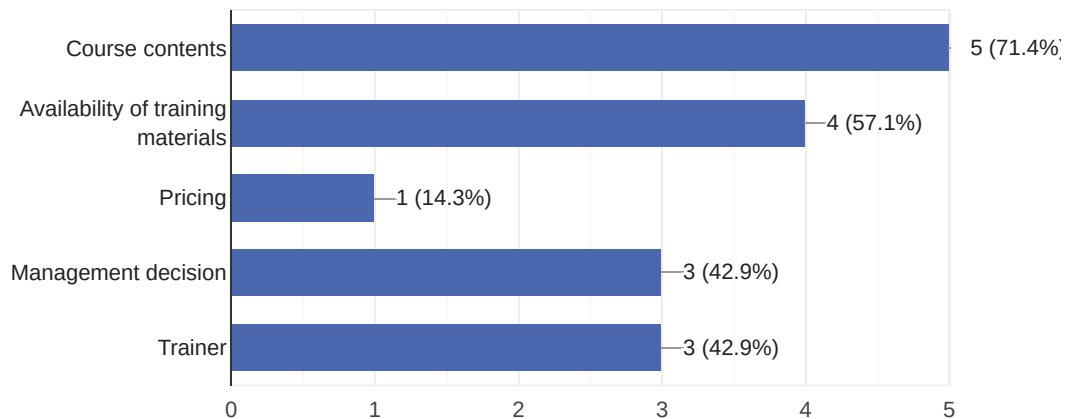
I liked the processes/sched/irq the least, but that's probably because that's a topic I haven't encountered a lot at work and I struggle with it whenever I came across the theory involved.
