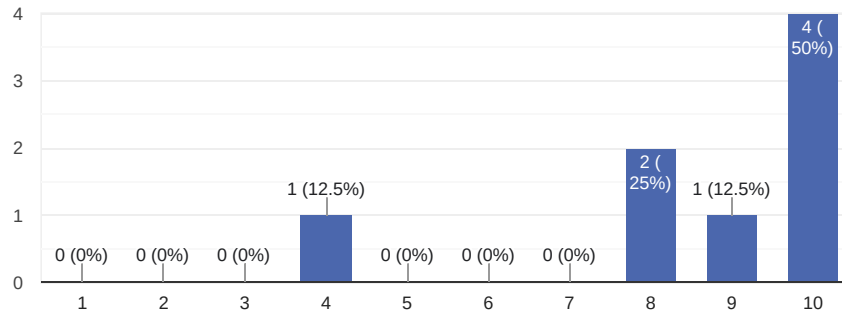

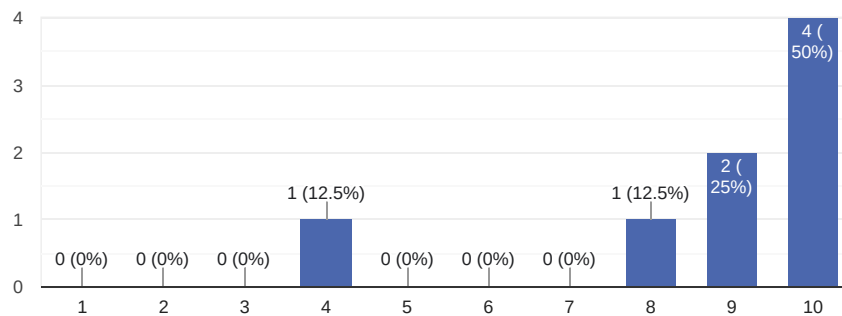

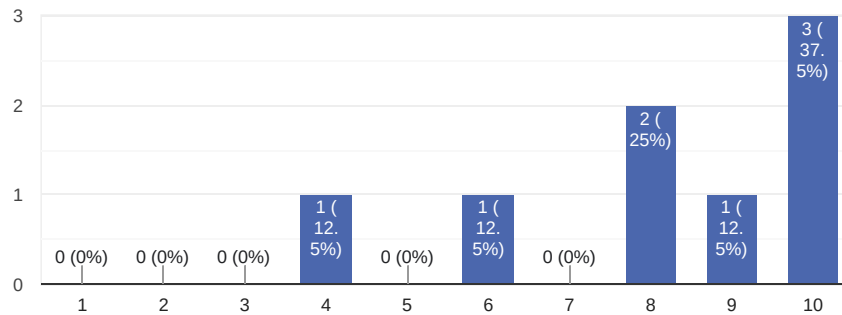

It is very useful and clear but sometimes the demo was too quick to understand things (especially the DMA lab).

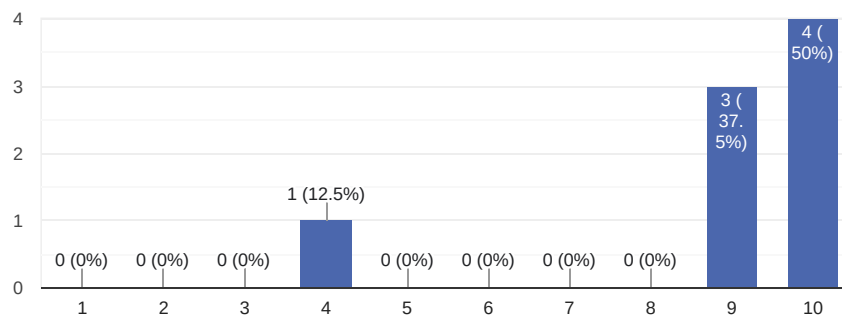
Good examples inside to understand better the theory.

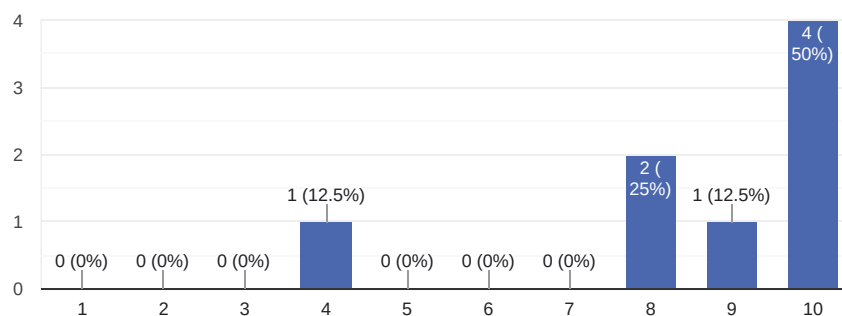

I appreciate the culture and the experience of Gregory

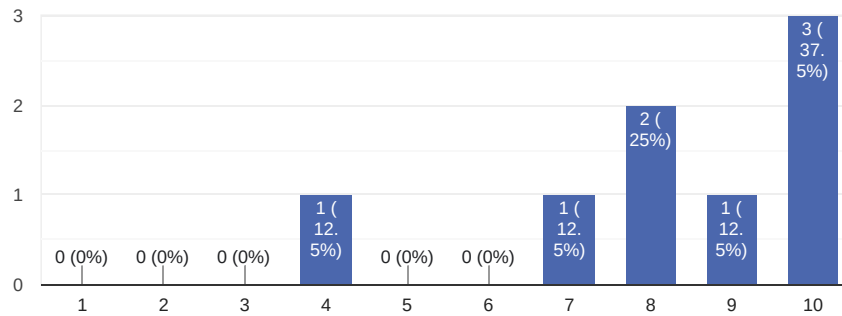
Greg is very experimented and his speech is very usefull for the lab and lecture explanation.

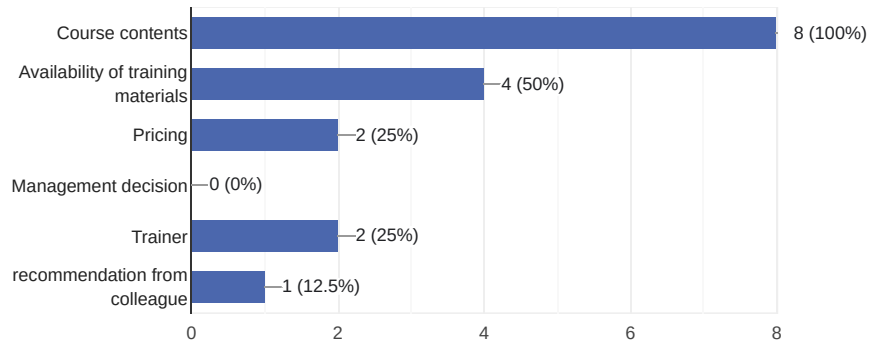
The course is quite dense, and the 8:30AM start time makes it a little hard to stay focused
