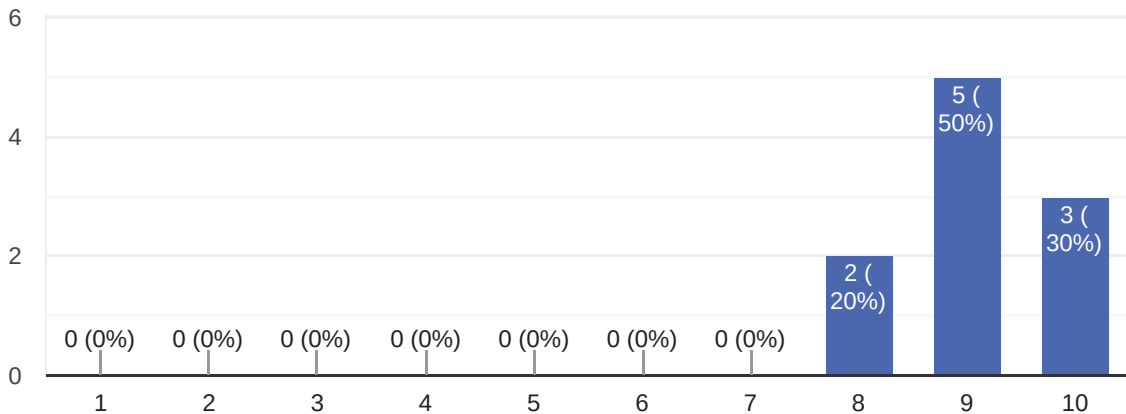

Well prepared, excellent presentations and exercises. Marcos presented the subjects greatly and clearly, and was very helpful during the lab exercises.

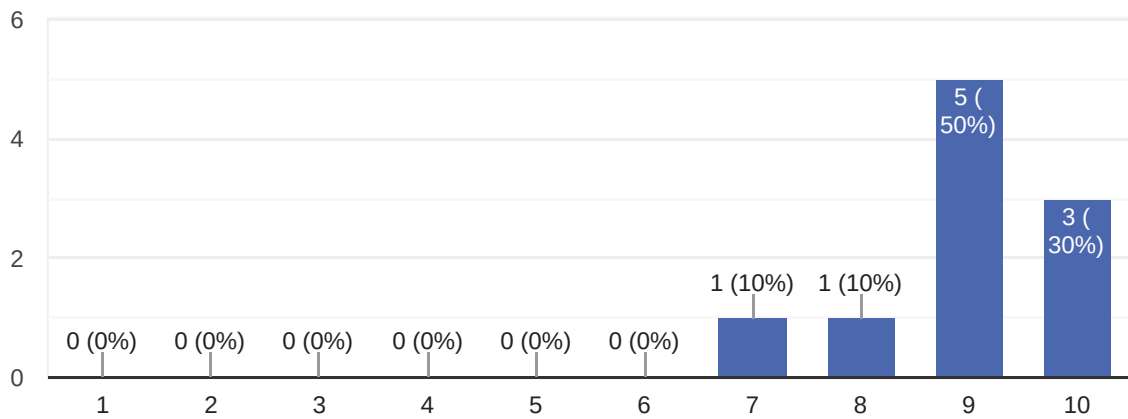
Very interesting with a dynamic presenters and fun lab work with real hardware.

Over all very good. I think there were too many slides. I would have preferred more dense slides.

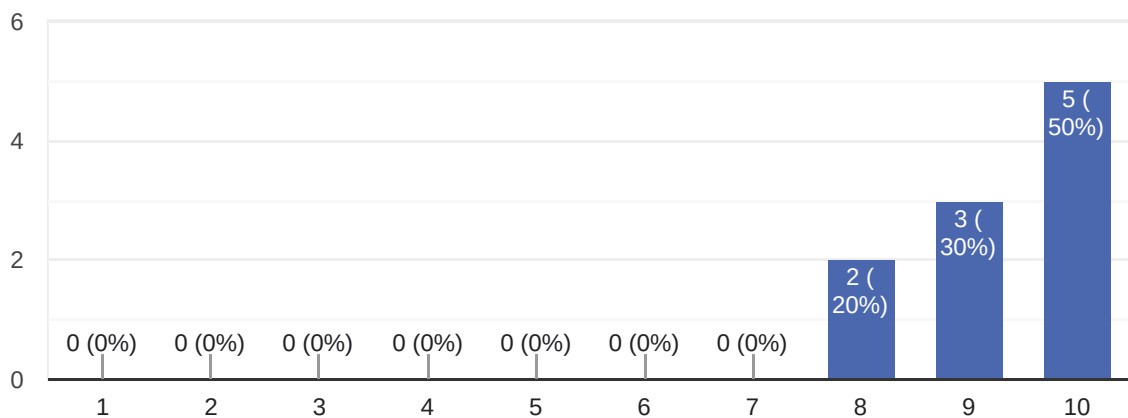

Very good. I think they covered everything you need to know to develop your own.

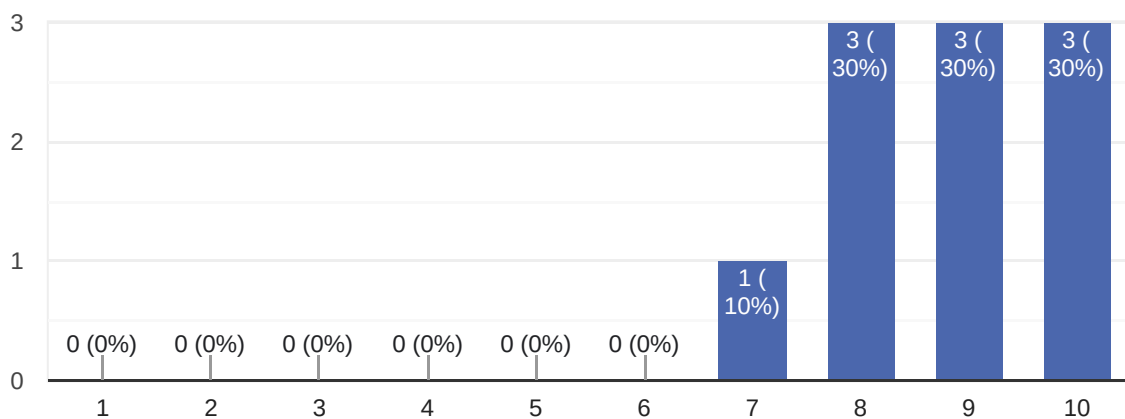
Excellent guides in the labs and excellent help from the instructor.

Maybe it would be better to have 2-4 hours more so that you don't get stressed and can get through the whole course without time pressure.

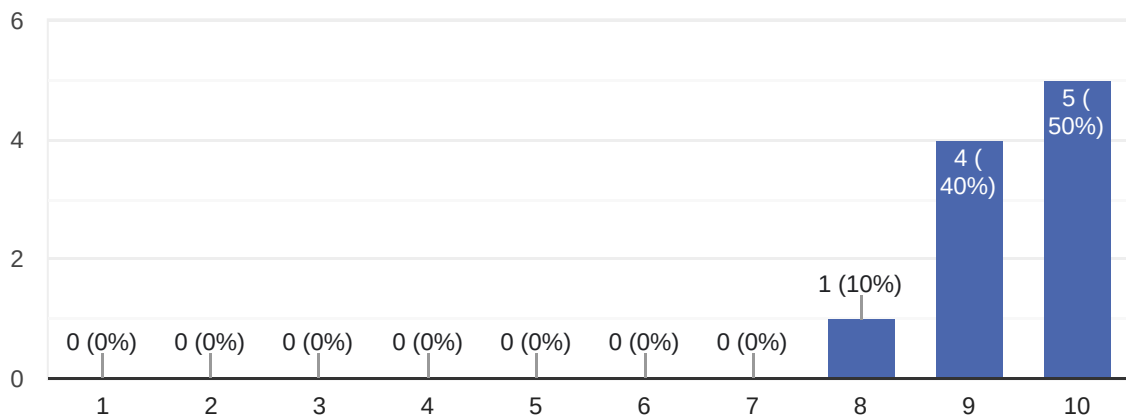

Almost all questions expertly answered. Swift guidance to unblock every participant who were stumped by any task in the labs

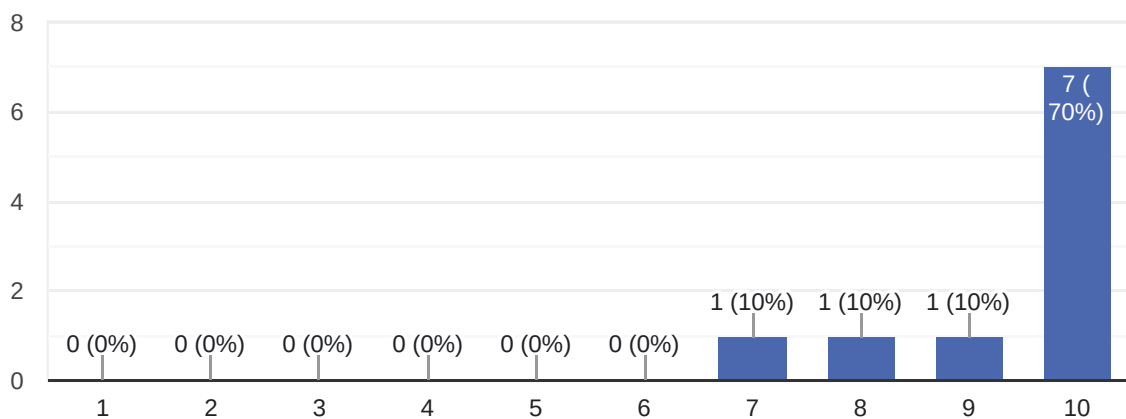

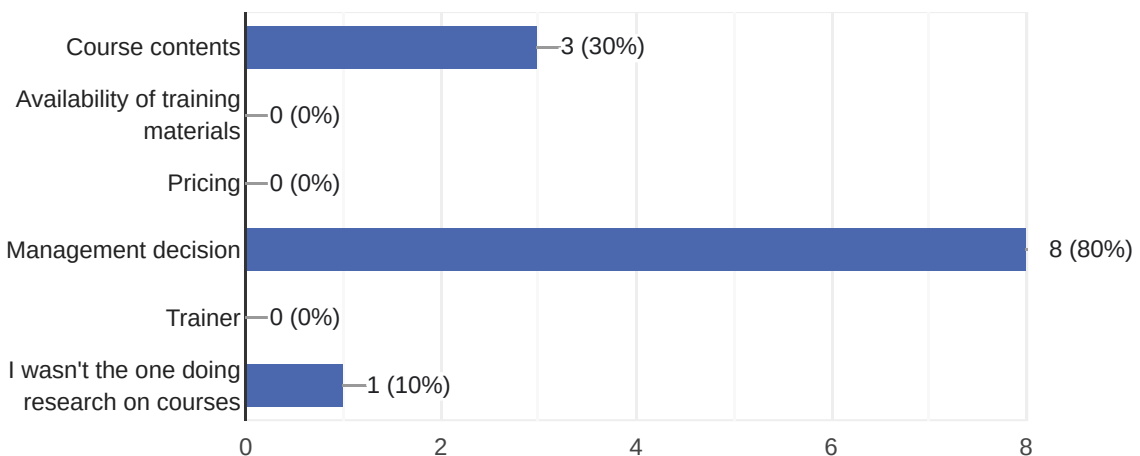
