



The labs complemented the theoretical knowledge learnt in the slides. I think it helped understand the material when the instructor would talk about a concept and we would do the corresponding lab right away.





I think the labs were the most interesting part of the course. It was engaging and allowed me to independently solve my bugs, which helped me gain a better understanding.




