

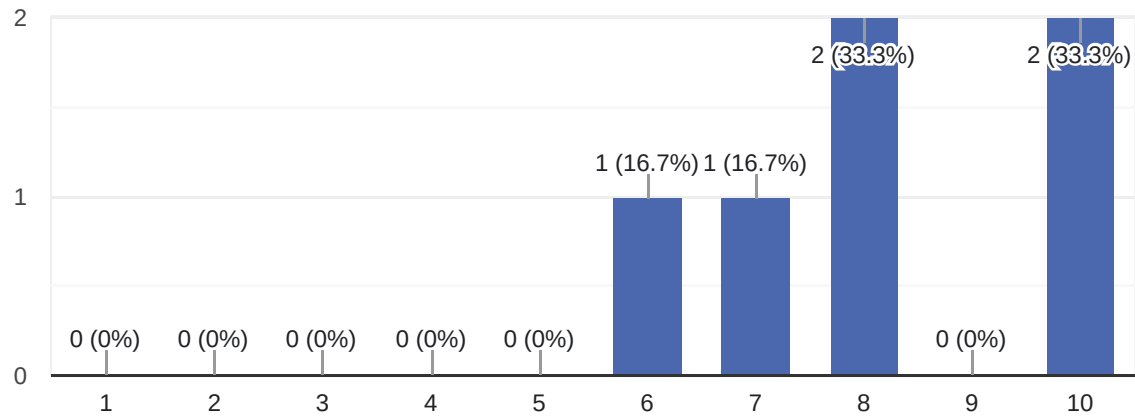

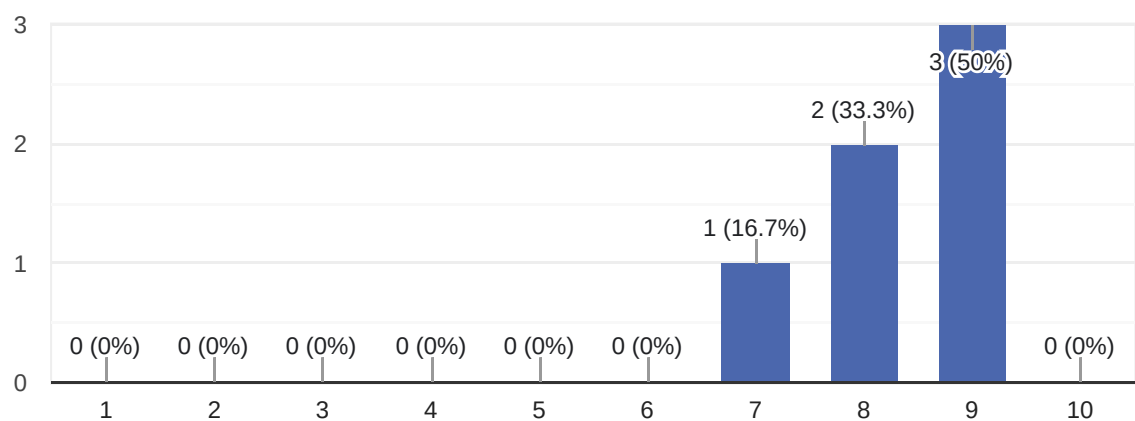
Good contents, clear slides and labs, and knowledgeable instructor

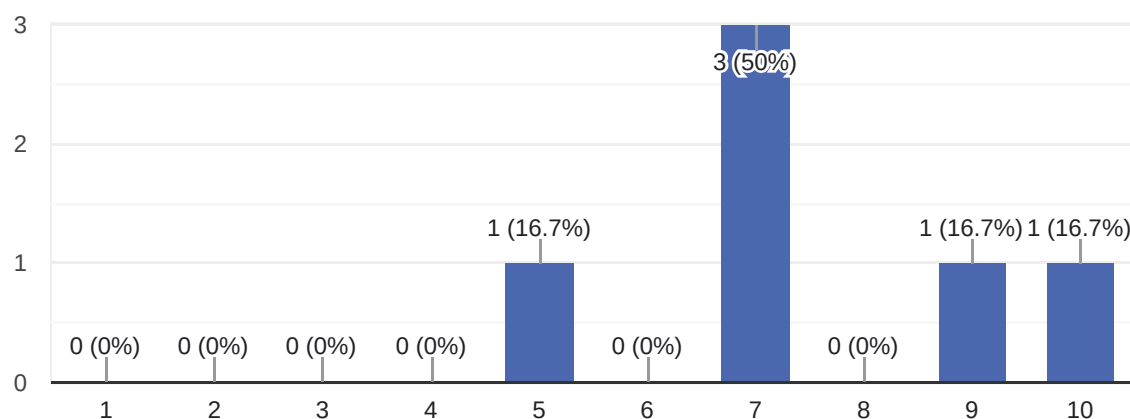
On several occasions I felt that the course content could be better organized, as there were concepts already seen previously that were explained afterwards.

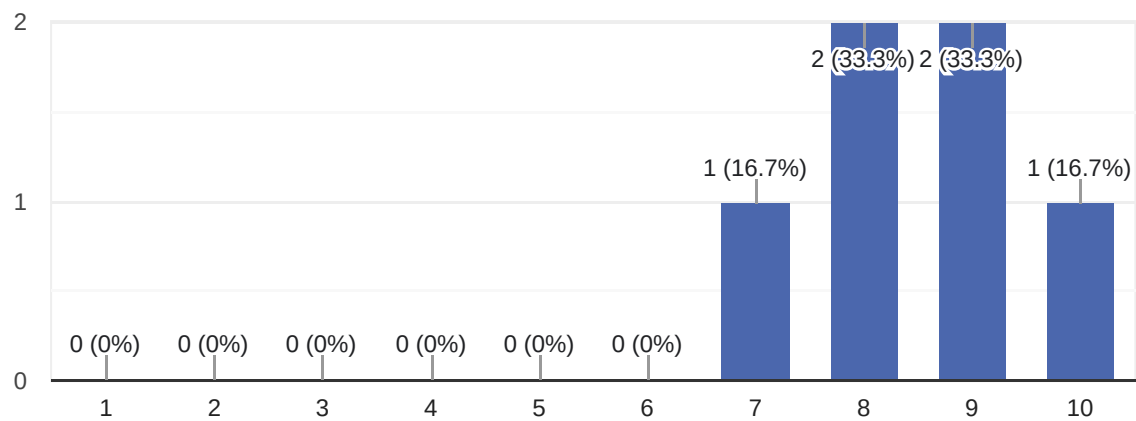
